PASTOR'S NOTES: Peter tells us that the apostles did not make it up when they spoke of the "power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ" and how he, James, and John were "eyewitnesses of his majesty" on that holy mountain when God made known from majestic alory that Jesus was his beloved Son. He savs further that we "will do well to be attentive to this prophecy like a "lamp shining in a dark place " (see 2 Peter 1:16-19). We still profess in the Nicene Creed on Sundays, "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end." In the first reading the prophet Daniel tells of one like the "Son of Man" coming in glory... His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not be taken away, his kingship shall not be destroyed" (See Dan 7:9-10, 13-14). Christians have interpreted the Transfiguration as foreshadowing Jesus coming in glory at the end of time. If we are in a good space we can confess with confidence the end of the Nicene Creed, "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." If we are not in a good space, we confess our sins to be prepared for his coming in glory. I will go under the knife on August 22nd for a right hip replacement, so I will go to confession and receive Anointing of the Sick, although complications are rare. The thing that gives me consolation is that Jesus is a friend of sinners. He takes his three friends up that high mountain by themselves. He wanted to share his time and life with each of them. We can pass time in his presence in a special way when we visit the Blessed Sacrament in the Church. We have the opportunity to feed our judge before we stand before him to receive the verdict. In Matthew's gospel when he comes in glory surrounded by the angels he will say, "Come, receive the kingdom prepared for you... for I was hungry and you fed me." You may want to join me as I send another donation to feed the hungry in Haiti, to feed the judge before I am judged by the Son of Man who took their part. Fr. Tim
