PASTOR'S NOTES: We continue with the theme of the vineyard this weekend. One son says, "No" to the father after being asked to ao to the vinevard but changes his mind and goes; the other says, "Yes" but never goes. We have to ask ourselves are we saying, "Yes" to God and doing the hard work of the kingdom. That means minimally going to church on Sundays but also keepina out parish alive by activities, faith formation, and being willing to share our faith. The good news is that we can always change our minds and get to work. We have all failed to do what God's wants us to do. We always start mass acknowledging that we need God's mercy, but hopefully that also gives us the desire to change our ways. We confess, "I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do." God is summoning us and we do not always respond. In the third Eucharistic Prayer at Mass the priest says. "Listen graciously to the prayers of this family whom you have summoned before you..." Can you imagine if the judge summoned you to appear in court and you just didn't show? There would be consequences! God summons us to Mass to remember that His son died for us. We acclaim together right in the middle of the Eucharistic Prayer, "We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again." St. Paul writes, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" (I Cor 11:26). We should also prepare ourselves to receive him properly. St. Paul goes on to say, "Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be answerable for the body and blood of the Lord. Examine yourselves, and only then eat of the bread and drink of the cup" (I Cor 11:27-28). The good news is that Jesus has aiven us the Sacrament of Reconciliation to confess our sins and be absolved so we can receive again. Jesus commanded, "Do this in remembrance of me!" Does that sound
