PASTORS'S NOTES: Jesus came that we might have life and have it to the fullest. Pentecost completes the reason why Jesus came. Jesus wanted an on-going presence in the world, and his bride the church would carry out his work. He promised to be with his church until the end of the ages. We read in the Catechism paragraph 1076, "The Church was made manifest to the world on the day of Pentecost by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The gift of the Spirit ushers in a new era in the 'dispensation of the mystery' – the age of the Church during which Christ manifests, makes present, and communicates his work of salvation through the liturgy of his Church, 'until he comes." Jesus comes to us and touches us through the Sacraments that are celebrated as we live in the Spirit. The Ordained call down the Holy Spirit upon the gifts of bread and wine so that they become Jesus' Body and Blood. Jesus said that we as human beings, even with all our sins, know how to give good things to our children when they ask, so God, the Father, will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask (see Luke 11:11). I hope you have made it a habit to ask for the Holy Spirit. At confirmation the bishop prays over us saving, "All powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit you freed your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgment and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence." These gifts are called by different names sometimes because each gift is manifold and one word does not express it fully, for example the Gift of "wonder and awe" has been called "fear of the Lord;" "reverence" - "piety;" "courage" - "fortitude;" "right judgment" -"counsel." Just as in the Sacraments the Church calls down the Spirit, may we call down the Spirit upon us and our families every day of our lives. Fr. Tim
