

PASTORS'S NOTES: The mystery of the Trinity cannot be fully known, but that does not mean that we are cut off from the truth of God. Jesus says that the Spirit will reveal mysteries to the Church. "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth." John goes on to tell us that the Spirit will not speak on his own, but what he says will be in union with the Father and the Son. The Spirit will take what is the Father and Son's and declare it to the Church. The mystery of the Trinity says that all three want or "will" the same, and all three act together. There is never competition but they are on the same team... We talk about the different aspects of being human, such as, our will or choice; our mind or our way of thinking; our heart or feelings; our strength (or the ability to put into action what we want and choose to do). Because of sin we are often divided and unable to make up our minds or follow through on what we have decided to do. That is not the case with God. The power of the Spirit within us can make us become more and more like God. Jesus says that we are to love God with all our heart, soul, strength and mind, not half way. This love of God leads us to action "to love our neighbor as our self." You may recognize this as the great commandment. In Luke's gospel (as well as Mark's gospel) the evangelist mentions that you need to love God "with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself" (Luke 10:27). God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy spirit are one in heart, soul, strength and mind. All three are one in love (all loving), one in being (internal life, God always existed and will exist), strength (all powerful), mind (all knowing), and one in action of love, as God is creating, redeeming and sanctifying humanity. The plurality of three refers to their relationship. The Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Father, and the Holy Spirit is not the Father or Son. God is a

community and yet completely one. We continue to invite the Holy Spirit into our life so that we can become more authentic or wholesome in who we are, what we want, how we love, and be more able to do what we know we should do. Come Holy Spirit! Fr. Tim
