PASTORS'S NOTES: "Give them some food vourselves," Jesus tells his disciples (see Luke 9:13). The disciples were concerned about the crowd because of the "deserted place" where they were and they could not find food there. Of course, the disciples did not have enough to feed them but they brought the five loaves and two fish they had to Jesus and he feeds them all. Jesus wanted them to be part of the miracle. He wants us to be more than observers but to bring what we have to him and amazing things will happen. Not only did the disciples bring what they had to Jesus, but they also were part of distributing it to the hungry. I am ashamed to say most of the time we don't bring what we have to Jesus and ask him to use what we have to feed the world. It would be good if during Mass we put what we have on the altar as an offering and ask Jesus to direct us on how we are to use it. That would apply for our time, treasure and talents. Another part of this weekend's message is how it pertains to receiving Jesus' most holy Body and Blood. St. Paul passes on what he himself had received. He received the truth that is the Eucharist from the Lord and he passed it on to everyone. We are not being very successful at passing on to our children how important Mass is; that receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus is our life-line to heaven. As we take the Mass seriously, children will take note. If we don't miss Mass even in the harvest or when we are on vacation, our children will be amazed and take note. They know if we are going, just when it is convenient. The more it is a sacrifice to go, the more influence we will have on passing it on. In my father's generation, many Catholics struggled with "turning a wheel" on Sunday, but many would never think about skipping Mass. I will never forget when there was a blizzard on Sunday. Dad judged that it was not too bad to drive the mile and half to town for Mass. He even held the door open so he could see the center line until he got firmly on the road. Even though that is not what I would expect all of you to do, that action really told us children that the Mass was a life and death matter. In John's gospel Jesus says that unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you shall not have life within you. If we don't have Life with in us, we are dead in the water. "Give them some food yourselves" also means passing this truth on by what we say and how we live. Fr. Tim
