**PASTORS'S NOTES:** There are a lot of great things that can happen in life: financial gifts, good health and long life, a great education, talents that make most things come easy to you, you could have received and developed your emotional intelligence so you can focus and empathize with others. You could receive a great paying job and love the work you do. You could marry someone you love and your spouse loves you. And have children that are all healthy, good looking and wise. You could have great spiritual experiences, retreats and mystic meditation. Yet all that is NOTHING if your name is not written in heaven. The disciples come back to Jesus celebrating this week because the demons were subject to them. "Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name." Jesus rejoiced with them as well but gave them the real reason that they should rejoice. "Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10:20). All those good things I mentioned above are gifts that could help us along the way, but maybe those aifts could become the source of pride and arrogance especially when everything comes easy for you but others struggle. There is a possibility that contempt for your fellow human beings could enter your heart. The most important thing from this life is that we end up in heaven. Someone once said somethina like the following: Earthly life is but the childhood of our eternity. I came across another phrase recently that really underscores the importance of our journey. We often hear "Life is short you had better enjoy it" but what about the flip side of that "eternity is long you had better prepare for it." Do we really believe there is a heavenly reality? If so, prepare for it now. If you have bitterness or hatred in your heart, do you really want to live with that bitterness for eternity? That would not be heaven!!! If you do not want to live with it forever, then ask God today, not tomorrow, to send the Holy Spirit into your heart to purify it. May we make a firm resolve to receive Jesus in the Sacraments and turn firmly to him so that we can rejoice that our names are written in heaven. Fr. Tim
