PASTORS'S NOTES: It is a challenge to be attentive to someone so that we can truly serve them. And to serve is important, after all, Jesus said that he came to serve not to be served. Christians have to figure out what it means to serve others. Some people think that to serve them is to do exactly what they tell you to do. It would be blatantly wrong to do what they say if you know it to be morally wrong. It does not do anyone any good for their salvation to help them do wrong or sin. For example, some spouses are abusive. We know that they don't become the people they are called to be unless someone "stands up" to them. I was just talking to a retired teacher and she was saying that to hold to the rules is very important for teaching children. Without holding to that basic truth, and everybody gives the person what they want, that person will become an abusive citizen believing that he or she never has to follow the law. Applying this to the gospel, Jesus tells Martha that she has become "anxious and worried about many things." Jesus continues, "there is need of only one thing." At that moment Mary who was listening to Jesus was doing what the Lord wanted. She was attentive to him. We all have to be attentive to what the Lord wants to go down the right road. There is definitely a time to kick into action and service, but if we are working for something that is not the Lord's wish, the harder we work the farther we will be from the Lord. They tell people who are lost in the wilderness to sit down and wait because the more they run the harder they will be to find. Mary was listening to Jesus to hear his wisdom. Martha was serving, and Jesus truly holds service as important, but she was "anxious and worried" so she needed to connect with Jesus before she continued. She did a wise thing. She came to Jesus as we should each day! Fr. Tim
