PASTORS'S NOTES: We, the living, need to go to Jesus so that we can help our loved ones who have died. Jesus says, "I will not reject anyone who comes to me..." (John 6:37b) We have All Saints Day on November 1st and that is normally a Holy Day of Obligation, except if it lands on Saturday or Monday. The obligation is removed, but it remains a Holy Day. We have the promise that many people have made it to heaven and that this communion of Saints can assist us with their prayers especially when we are in communion with Jesus and them at Mass. The next day Nov 2nd we have All Souls Day which is like a big funeral for all our loved ones who have died. They cannot assist themselves to enter heaven, but we can assist them. Even before they make it to the fullness of peace in heaven, they can pray for us. The more we help them, the more they can help us. As the funeral vigil rite says, "We believe that all the ties of affection which knit us as one throughout our lives do not unravel with death..." These ties, this affection keeps us in communion. We have this tradition that we publicize names of people for a special intention at Mass. Most of the time it is for the eternal rest of someone. They are still striving to enter the fullness of the kingdom. And as St. Paul says when one member suffers the whole body suffers. When one is honored, we are all honored. None of our prayers are wasted. If we pray for someone who has already entered into the fullness of peace, those prayers bind us together in a deeper communion. We become like Jesus who came to us in our need. The first reading says that the "souls of the just are in the hand of God." (Wisdom 3:1a) It reminds that we need to work for justice even now so we can be in the hand of God. The gospel acclamation from Matthew 25:34 should also remind us that the ones Jesus is saying "Come, you blessed by my Father" are the ones who worked for justice and who took care of the hungry, thirsty, naked, the stranger, the sick, the ones in prison. We go to Jesus in this world in different ways, but a key part is when we tend to Jesus in the needy. Fr Tim
