



A believer in redemptive love, he continues to be an inspiration and an example for those who seek to make positive change in the world, to address inequities, and to ensure human rights and dignity for others.

The following is a favorite sentiment Dr. King shared in his letter from the Birmingham Jail, where he was held following his arrest at a rally to end segregation at lunch counters: "I cannot sit idly by in Atlanta and not be concerned about what happens in Birmingham. Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere. We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality, tied in a single garment of destiny. Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly."








What is a Memorial?

A memorial provides an opportunity to perpetuate the memory or give special honor to a loved one in a way that both gives glory to God and helps our Parish. You may choose to dedicate a special item in memory of a deceased parent, child, or other special person. Or you may honor someone on a special occasion, such as a milestone birthday or wedding anniversary.

Items Available to Memorialize

St. Mary Parish has completed a major renovation of its historic church. There are many beautiful items to be memorialized throughout.

HOLY FAMILY HALL STAINED GLASS WINDOW

A prominent engraved memory plaque will be hung with all the names of those who contributed to the window - \$1,000 (goal of 200 contributors)

8 ADORATION CHAPEL WINDOWS

A small engraved brass plate with a name or quote will be placed under each window memorialized - \$15,000

14 STATIONS OF THE CROSS

A small engraved brass plate with a name or quote will be placed under each station memorialized - \$10,000

34 PEWS

A small engraved brass plate with a name or quote will be placed on each end of the memorialized pew - \$1,500

Upon request, a personal announcement will be sent to whomever the donor designates.


