Halloween and Upcoming Events Halloween Guidelines

- 1. We will allow costumes to be worn during the school day (see below) on October 31st.
- 2. We will be doing a small "Trick or Treating" event with some of our Parish and School staff handing out Halloween trinkets (no candy) to our

students in a safe manner outside of the school on Monday, October 31. We will be providing Halloween bags and staff members will be handing out Halloween items to all of our students.

Costume Guidelines: Costumes are optional. Students can wear black and orange if they are not wanting to wear a costume. Students should be able to put on their costume independently (or remove it independently). Costumes should be



worn over their clothes at school (students will not be able to change in the bathrooms). Please do not send costume accessories. No make-up or face painting, please. Costumes should be school-appropriate (no gore; not scary; no weapons). No masks. The costumes can be worn all day or taken off after our "trick or treating" activity at 12:10. Students should be aware that they will be wearing costumes all day, including at recess and in PE class.


Exciting Theatre Opportunity with Totino- Grace Fine Arts Academy!



School Visitors and Volunteers

In an effort to provide a safe and secure campus, office staff will be screening visitors wishing to gain entrance by asking for your name and the purpose of your visit. After being buzzed into the building, please proceed directly to the school office on the main floor. If you are staying for a scheduled meeting or to volunteer, please note that you must sign in electronically and obtain a badge (either a one-time-use visitor sticker or a reusable volunteer badge for those who are Virtus-approved volunteers).

If you plan to volunteer in the school this year, please allow time to complete the Virtus background check process at <u>virtusonline.org</u> before you will be in the classroom (2 weeks is generally sufficient). Thank you.

Reporting Absences

When your child will be absent, late, or need to be dismissed early, please report this to the school office before 7:45 AM. You can send us an email at attendance@mysaintrose.net. Please provide your child's name, teacher, and reason for the absence. It is important that we know why your child will be absent, as it helps us track illnesses. Thank you for your cooperation!

Hot Lunch

For many years Saint Rose of Lima has partnered with Roseville Public Schools to provide our hot lunch program. Prior to COVID-19 and lunches being free for everyone for the last couple of years, it was a goal of mine to get Saint Rose of Lima on the Roseville School district's lunch system, which would allow parents to set up automatic payments, track students' lunch balances and not need to send checks or cash to school.

We are thankful and very excited to say that we are going to be making that transition on November 1st! Some of our Saint Rose families might already have an account set up if there are other students in the district's public schools. If not, <u>click here to go to Titan</u> through Roseville School District to set up a lunch account.

Changes coming:

- All money currently in student accounts will be transferred to Titan effective 11/1 (we apologize for the confusion if you have already started to enter money into your child's Titan account before this changeover occurred. Rest assured, your money is there and will show up for use 11/1).
- Personal Identification Numbers (PINs) will be used at the point of sale that children will be asked to memorize.
 - PINs will be distributed later this week with a PIN practice sheet to help the lunch line go smoothly and quickly.
 - Please work with your child(ren) to get this memorized.
 - School Staff/Lunchroom Volunteers will assist during this process until everyone gets the hang of it.
- Money can be entered online in the Titan Family Portal or, to avoid the \$2.60 convenience charge, cash or check can still be sent in to school.
- School menus are also available through the Portal.

Please make sure that you set up an account by November 1st or check your existing account to ensure that all children are represented. We ask that you continue to keep a

It's Not Too Late to Apply for Educational Benefits!

The Application for Educational Benefits (formerly known as Free and Reduced Lunch) can be completed by any <u>family who thinks they may qualify</u>. An eligibility notice letter will arrive via mail or email within 10 business days.

- 1. Visit TITAN K-12 Family Portal.
- 2. Click on Apply for Meals Today (log in not required).
- 3. Follow the instructions to complete your online application.

Additional Information:

- One application needed per family *each year*. Families who qualified for benefits last school year have until **October 18th** to apply for uninterrupted benefits this year. After that date, any families who have not applied will lose benefits until their application is completed and approved.
- The <u>income thresholds</u> are higher than in some programs, so many families are surprised to find they DO qualify.

We implore ALL families to fill out the Application for Educational Benefits form if you <u>qualify financially</u> EVERY year. This form determines **funding for our school** and provides direct benefits for your child and others if you qualify. Benefits include funding for:

- Free or reduced lunch prices for meals offered at school
- Social workers, paraprofessionals, and counselors
- Increased technology
- Early childhood education
- Additional funding for educator professional development

As a reminder, ALL families who receive Tuition Assistance from Saint Rose are required to apply each year, if you meet the <u>income guidelines</u>.


