

# MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH SYLLABUS

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- **Bring to Class Everyday**

- **Assignments**

Students are given nightly assignments. Assignments include bookwork, worksheets, or IXL. Assignments are given to help students understand the material. Late assignments must be turned in before the end of the chapter to receive credit.

- **Tests/Quizzes/Projects**

There is a test at the end of each chapter. Some chapters are longer, so instead of one big test, the chapter is divided into smaller quizzes. In some chapters, a project will replace the chapter test.

- **Corrections**

Students can make corrections on assignments and tests/quizzes. Full credit is received on assignment corrections, and half-credit is received on test/quiz corrections as long as all work is shown. If the student chooses to make corrections, ALL corrections need to be completed. A guardian signature on the test/quiz will be required for the student to make corrections. Corrections are due by the end of the week they were initially passed back. Corrections should be stapled on top of the original assignment or test/quiz.

- **Extra Credit**

Extra credit is not regularly available in math class. Students will be informed if an opportunity arises. Students are not eligible for extra credit if they have missing work.

- **Sycamore**

Sycamore is used regularly in class. Parents and students should check Sycamore on a weekly basis to stay informed about assignments, tests, grades, and missing work.

- **Grading Policy**

Student grades are weighted as follows:

Letter grades will be determined using the Middle School Grading Scale.
