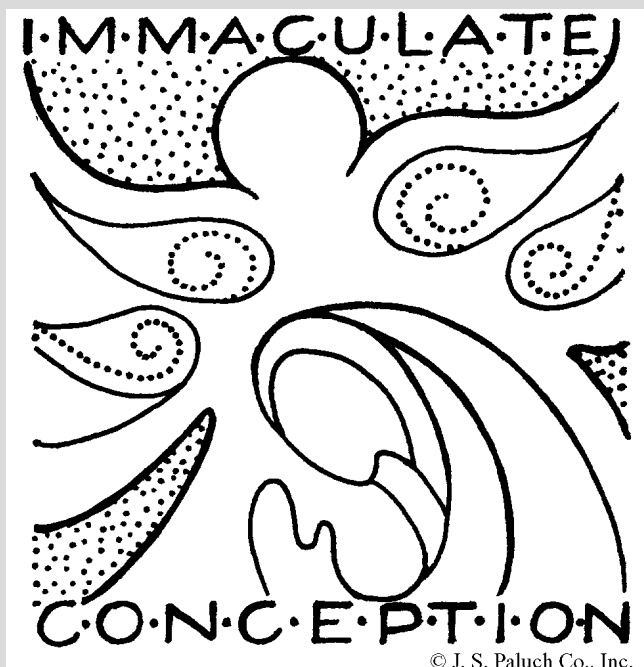
Our ADVENT Journey.....

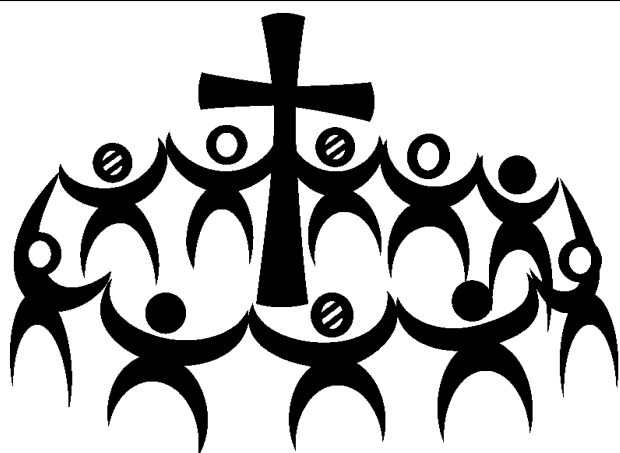
