Next weekend there will be a second collection at the Masses to help support the work of SVdP.


Retrovaille

Marriage issues have intensified for many couples during COVID-19. Retrouvaille has come up with a great program to help couples learn how to have a great marriage.

The next in person program will begin on **September 15th**. This weekend program will begin Friday evening, all day Saturday and Sunday and then be followed by a series of virtual post weekend sessions.

Retouvaille is NOT group therapy and couples are not asked to share their problems or story with anyone else.

The program focuses on teaching communication skills between a husband and a wife. Couples are gided through the weekend by a team who have been through the program themselves. What happened to the mustard seed? What happens to bread when you add yeast? How is this like the Kingdom of heaven?
