



## St. Vincent de Paul News


We thank you for your continued generosity and support of the SVdP ministry. This past month we were able to help 366 families, that's about 92 families each week.

## Retrovaille




Marriage issues have intensified for many couples during COVID-19. Retrouvaille has come up with a great program to help couples learn how to have a great marriage.

The next in person program will begin on **September 15th**. This weekend program will begin Friday evening, all day Saturday and Sunday and then be followed by a series of virtual post weekend sessions.

Retrouvaille is NOT group therapy and **couples are not asked to share their problems or story with anyone else.**

The program focuses on teaching communication skills between a husband and a wife. Couples are guided through the weekend by a team who have been through the program themselves. 

## Reflection Corner

**What happened to the mustard seed? What happens to bread when you add yeast? How is this like the Kingdom of heaven?**



The Kingdom of heaven is so grand and mysterious that Jesus gave us parables to help us ponder its greatness. We hear that the smallest of all seeds grows into the largest of plants, and the tiny yeast transforms flour into a large loaf of bread. Today's Gospel invites us to think deeply about how something so small can become something very large.
