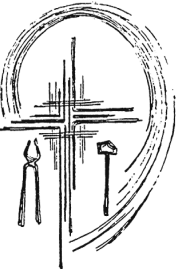

### What is the Veritas Conference?

Keynotes have featured a variety of international speakers; lay, ordained, and religious. Our speakers are dynamic and engaging, gifted in passing on their expertise and sharing the joy and light of discipleship to Christ. The 2025 Keynote Speaker is Mike Aquilina.

Veritas 2025 takes place on Saturday, September 13th. The theme for this year will be the Church Fathers. The Conference this year will be an opportunity to delve into our rich Catholic tradition and learn how to practically grow in your faith in any walk of life, through the practice of virtue.
