Associate Pastor's Message

FR. FLORENTINO VICTORINO

In the gospel, Jesus sends the 72 missionaries, to those towns that he was going to visit. He sends them, but he does not send them alone; He sends them two by two. When Jesus sends the 72, we would think that they are many, but Jesus warns them that the work is great and the workers are few. An aptitude open to the difficulty of the path; to how laborious the mission will be.

We are being invited to a transformation. From being mere spectators to what Jesus says and does; to be admirers and followers of the figure of Jesus. To really become his collaborators and share the work of his mission.

Jesus warns them that he is going to send them out as lambs among wolves. They will face tensions, difficulties and dangers. More warns them not to adopt a defensive and reticent position, but, on the contrary, to adopt measures that open them up to the encounter. They must be in a vulnerable position. "Do not carry money, backpack, or sandals."

Jesus wants that wherever we go, we serve. Eat and drink what you have, because the worker has the right to his salary. Presume that they are working and serving those around them; that they come to a place with a spirit of service, not that they came to a place for everyone to serve and pamper them. It is not about what they can demand, but what they can be open to receive.

The importance of shaking our feet. In that moment when we face difficulties, rejection, resistance, abuse and feel powerless in the face of situations, Christ does not want us to remain discouraged, suffering and feeling inadequate for the mission. Jesus wants us to get rid of that burden, offer it to him and continue on our way; that we take off that burden from above to fill ourselves with his peace, hope and love, which encourage us, again and again to try again.

Let us work knowing that the mission is not ours, it belongs to Jesus Christ. That we are merely "workers", one more of the many that are needed. If we are tempted to think that the mission depends on us, we are sure to fall into resentment and bitterness. But we can't keep that dust on our feet. We have to shake it, because it is dust.

In the same way, Christ deserves all the credit for the good that happens in our mission work. The good is not necessarily the sensational and spectacular, but the personal. The seventy-two disciples returned full of joy and said to Jesus: "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."

Jesus wants to let us know that the greatest joy is his salvation and at the same time warn us not to be fascinated and distracted by the sensational and spectacular. "Do not rejoice that the demons submit to you. Rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven."

Mensaje del Pastor Asociado

PADRE FLORENTINO VICTORINO

En el evangelio, Jesús envía a los 72 misioneros, a aquellos pueblos que él iba a visitar. Él los envía, pero no los envía solos; los envía de dos en dos. Cuando Jesús envía los 72, pensaríamos que son muchos, pero Jesús les advierte que el trabajo es mucho y los trabajadores pocos. Una aptitud abierta a la dificultad del camino; a lo trabajoso que será la misión.

Estamos siendo invitados a una transformación. De ser meramente espectadores a lo que Jesús dice y hace; de ser admiradores y seguidores de la figura de Jesús. A realmente volvernó colaboradores suyos y compartir el trabajo de su misión.

Jesús les advierte que les va a enviar como corderos entre lobos. Van a enfrentarse a tensiones, dificultades y peligros. Más les advierte que no deben adoptar una posición defensiva y reticente, sino que, por lo contrario, deben adoptar medidas que les abran al encuentro. Deben de estar en una posición vulnerable. “No lleven ni dinero, ni morral, ni sandalias”.

Jesús desea que a donde vayamos, sirvamos. Coman y beban de lo que tengan, porque el trabajador tiene derecho a su salario. Presume que están trabajando y sirviendo a los que les rodean; que llegan a un lugar con un espíritu de servicio, no que llegaron a un sitio para que todos le sirvan y les consientan. No se trata de lo que pueden exigir, sino lo que pueden estar abiertos a recibir.

La importancia de sacudirnos los pies. En ese momento cuando enfrentemos dificultades, rechazo, resistencias, abusos y nos sintamos impotentes ante las situaciones, Cristo no desea que nos quedemos desanimados, sufriendo y sintiéndonos inadecuados para la misión. Jesús desea que nos quitamos esa carga de encima, que se la ofrezcamos a él y sigamos nuestro camino; que nos quitemos esa carga de encima para llenarnos de su paz, esperanza y amor, que nos animan, una y otra vez a intentarlo de nuevo.

Trabajemos sabiendo que la misión no es nuestra, es de Jesucristo. Que somos meramente “trabajadores”, uno más de los muchos que se necesitan. Si somos tentados a pensar que la misión depende de nosotros, de seguro caemos en resentimientos y amargura. Pero no podemos quedarnos con ese polvo en los pies. Tenemos que sacudirlo, porque es polvo.

De la misma manera, Cristo merece todo el crédito por lo bueno que pase en nuestro trabajo de misión. Lo bueno, no necesariamente es lo sensacionalista y espectacular, sino lo personal. Los setenta y dos discípulos regresaron llenos de alegría y le dijeron a Jesús: “Señor, hasta los demonios se nos someten en tu nombre”.

Jesús quiere dejarnos saber que la alegría más grande es su salvación y a la vez advertirnos que no se fascinen y se distraigan por lo sensacionalista y espectacular. “No se alegren de que los demonios se les someten. Alégrense más bien de que sus nombres están escritos en el cielo”.

Teach your children what to do when they are lost

Preparing your children for a situation where they might get lost or separated from you can help resolve a scary situation more quickly. Talk to your children about what to do if they ever get lost in a crowd. First, tell them to stay where they are. Teach them how to locate another safe adult — a park or store employee, someone in uniform, another mom with children — and how to ask for help.

desaparecido para que otros a su alrededor también lo busquen.

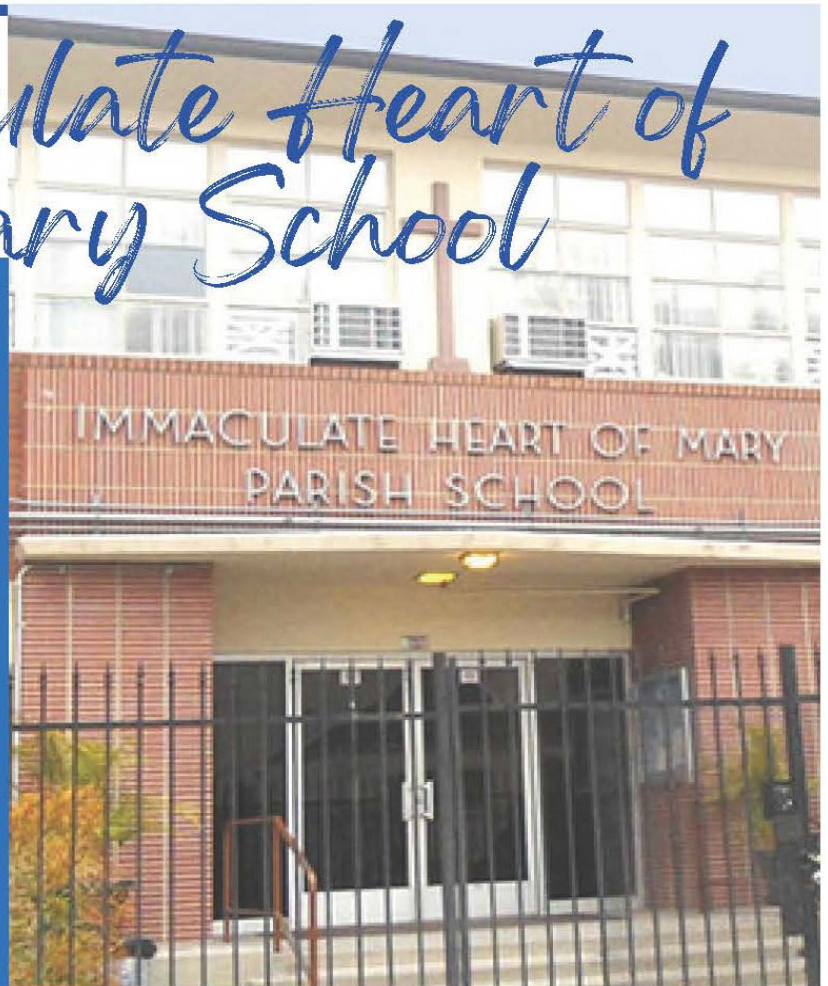

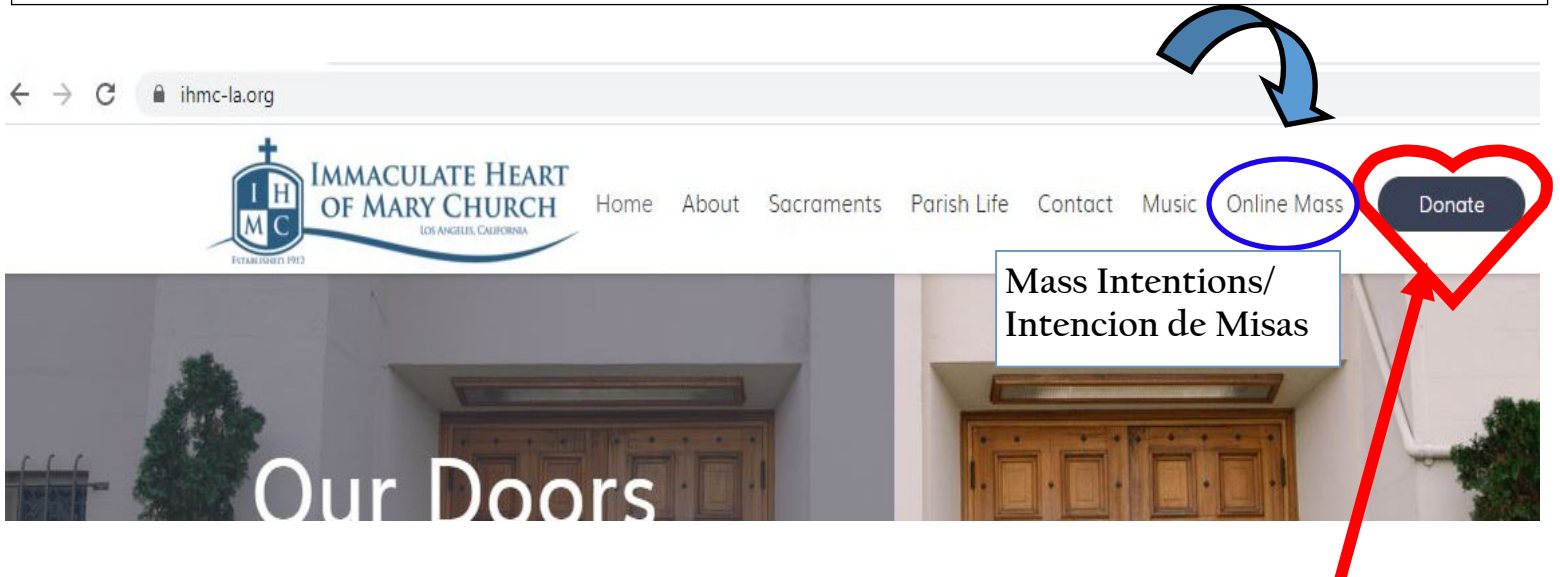

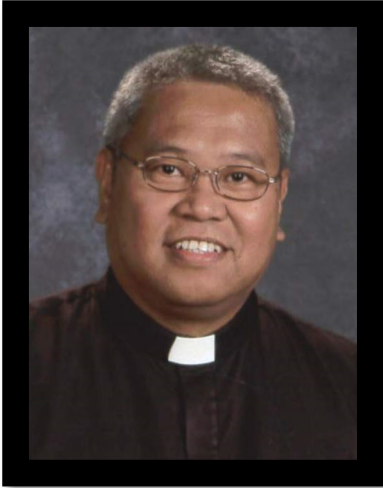
