Associate Pastor's Message

FR. FLORENTINO VICTORINO

Today it is easy to fall into the illusion. In part it is not our fault, society values the anxious, restless and dissatisfied person; always busy, always accumulating; climbing positions and social status.

The first reading presents this attitude to us as “vain illusion”. In our life, if we don't commit to a mutually supportive community; who loves and allows himself to be loved, we are destined for anxiety and despair. Phrases such as “he who keeps always has”, “he who asks for nothing, owes nothing” or “if I don't do it, no one will”, have an implication of isolation; deduces not believing in mutual love.

And this can lead us to feel alone, overwhelmed, with a huge load on our shoulders, not believing that there is anyone to help or rescue us when we face any difficulty.

God wishes, on the other hand, that we never feel alone and that we accept the call to form lives in community, as a vocation and instrument to get closer to God and to know God. The community can also be our instrument of peace.

The gospel presents us: A rich man obtained a great harvest. All of us have that great harvest: what we have, what we are as a person, what we know and our abilities. What do we do when we recognize our wealth? Do we put it at the service of others or do we accumulate it?

The rich man did not think of anyone but himself: I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones to store my harvest and everything I have. Then I will be able to tell myself: You already have assets accumulated for many years; rest, eat, drink and give yourself to the good life.

We may think that this man was greedy and selfish, but this man's story does not begin there. We wonder, then, what motivated him to make such a decision; we try to imagine the heart of this man.

Maybe this man was lonely. It may be that he had not felt a community of love. To think of self-sufficiency, that his well-being depended only on him; of what he accumulated. He probably thought that, if in the future, it suggested a time of need in his life, he would have no one to help him.

If the man, instead of storing it, had distributed all the harvest that was left over. Perhaps he would have strengthened the community and then be pleasantly surprised to know that this same community would support him in his days of need.

It is beautiful to open up to receive and discover the generosity of others and it is also beautiful to discover how much we have to give and the difference we make in the lives of others. If we can have such a relationship with others, we can also have such a relationship with God.

Entrusting our life to God means counting on God and trusting in his times and methods. It is not our speed, but yours; not our methods, but theirs. Even believing in God and committed to serving him, we can often think that it depends on us. And as a consequence, we isolate ourselves and others, we end up taking God out of the equation. We need others and we need God, the rest is wishful thinking.

Mensaje del Pastor Asociado

PADRE FLORENTINO VICTORINO

Hoy en día es fácil caer en la vana ilusión. En parte no es nuestra culpa, la sociedad valora a la persona ansiosa, inquieta e inconforme; siempre ocupada, siempre acumulando; escalando posiciones y estatus social.

La primera lectura nos presenta esta actitud como “vana ilusión”. En nuestra vida, si no nos comprometemos a una comunidad que se apoye mutuamente; que ame y se deje amar, estamos destinados a la ansiedad y la desesperanza. Frases como “el que guarda siempre tiene”, “el que nada pide, nada debe” o “si no lo hago yo, nadie lo hará”, tienen una implicación de aislamiento; deduce no creer en el amor mutuo.

Y esto nos puede llevar a sentirnos solos, abrumados, con una carga enorme sobre nuestros hombros, sin creer que haya nadie que nos ayude o nos rescate cuando nos enfrentamos a cualquier dificultad.

Dios desea, por el otro lado, que nunca nos sintamos solos y que aceptemos el llamado a formar vidas en comunidad, como vocación e instrumento para acercarnos a Dios y conocer a Dios. La comunidad puede ser también, nuestro instrumento de paz.

El evangelio nos presenta: Un hombre rico obtuvo una gran cosecha. Todos nosotros tenemos esa gran cosecha: lo que tenemos, lo que somos como persona, lo que conocemos y nuestras capacidades. ¿Qué hacemos cuando reconocemos nuestra riqueza? ¿Lo ponemos al servicio de otros o lo acumulamos?

El hombre rico, no pensó en nadie, sino en sí mismo: Derribaré mis graneros y construiré otros más grandes para guardar ahí mi cosecha y todo lo que tengo. Entonces podré decirme: Ya tienes bienes acumulados para muchos años; descansa, come, bebe y date a la buena vida.

Podemos pensar que este hombre era avaro y egoísta, pero la historia de este hombre no comienza allí. Nos preguntamos, entonces, qué le motivó a tomar una decisión así; tratamos de imaginar el corazón de este hombre.

Puede que este hombre se sentía solo. Puede ser, que no había sentido una comunidad de amor. Para pensar en la autosuficiencia, que su bienestar solo dependía de él; de lo que acumulara. Probablemente pensaba que, si en el futuro, sugiera un momento de necesidad en su vida, no tendría a nadie que le ayude.

Si el hombre, en vez de almacenarla, hubiera repartido toda la cosecha que sobró. Quizás hubiera fortalecido a la comunidad y luego recibir la grata sorpresa de saber que esta misma comunidad lo apoyaría en sus días de necesidad.

Es hermoso abrirse a recibir y descubrir la generosidad de otros y también es hermoso descubrir cuánto tenemos para dar y la diferencia que hacemos en la vida de otros. Si podemos tener una relación así con otros, también podemos tener una relación así con Dios.

Confiar a Dios nuestra vida, significa contar con Dios y confiar en sus tiempos y métodos. No es nuestra velocidad, sino la suya; no son nuestros métodos, sino los suyos. Aun creyendo en Dios y comprometidos a servirle, podemos a menudo llegar a pensar que depende de nosotros. Y como consecuencia, nos aislamos y aislamos a otros, terminamos sacando a Dios de la ecuación. Necesitamos a otros y necesitamos a Dios, el resto es vana ilusión.

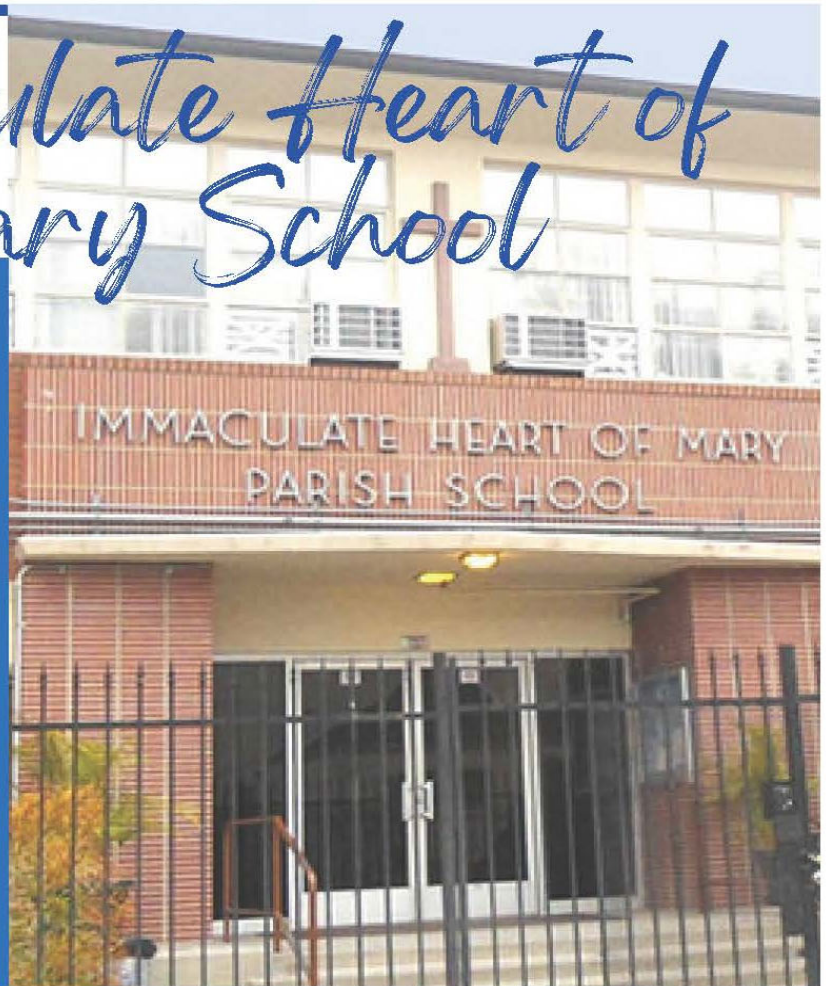

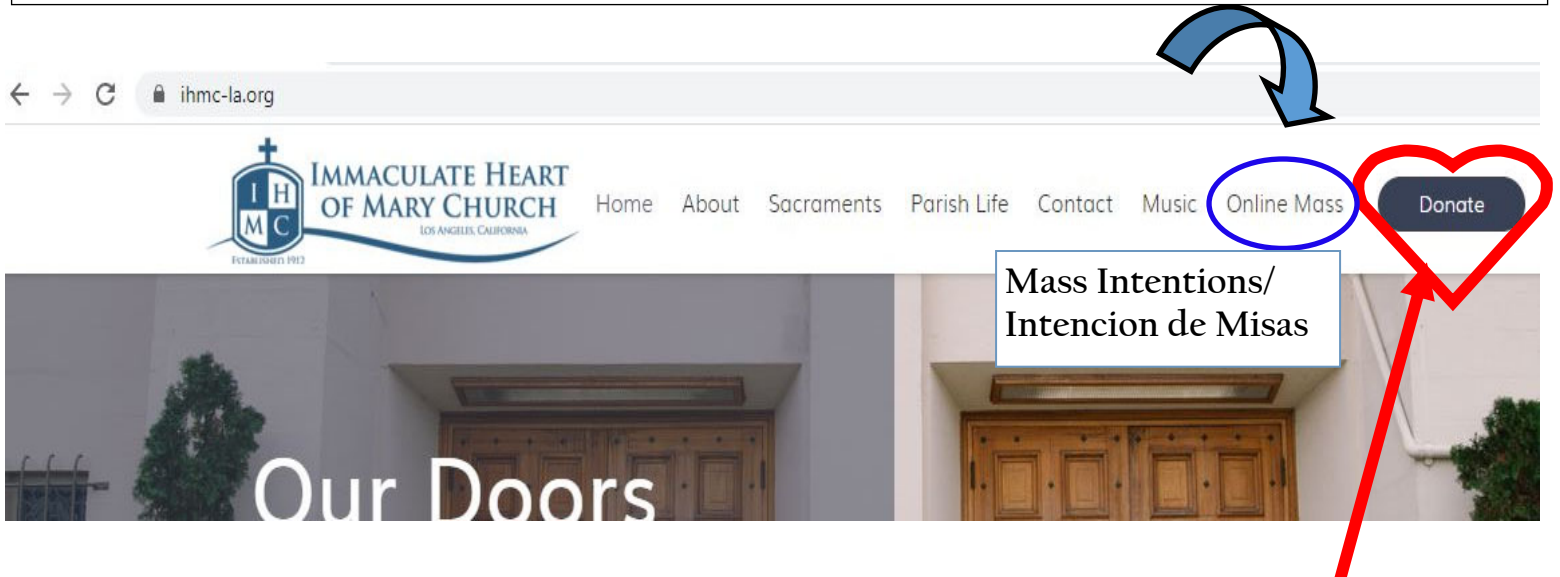

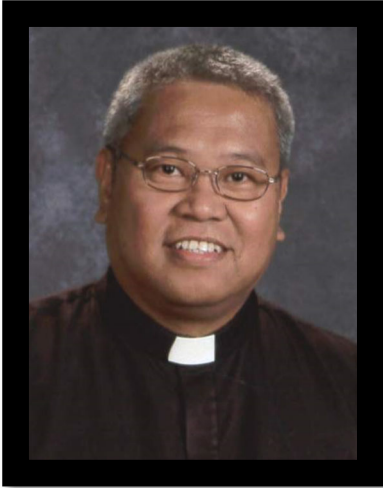
