Pastor's Message

FR. ROLANDO B. CLARIN

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, in the Gospel Reading, in a dream, God tells Joseph to marry Mary, even though Joseph had discovered she was pregnant. According to Jewish law, premarital sex is punishable by death; and, in the ordinary course of things, pregnancy doesn't occur without sex. So, Mary's pregnancy out of wedlock exposes her to the penalty of death. Even apart from legal penalties, Mary's pregnancy jeopardizes her flourishing. As Joseph's own attitude shows, in Mary's society, no one wants to marry a woman who looks like a sinful woman and has an illegitimate child to support.

It is clear, then, that Mary's pregnancy exposes her not only to legal penalties but also to suffering and shame in her society.

It is noteworthy too that Joseph needs to hear from God himself that God, and no man, is the father of Mary's child. Presumably, Joseph had already asked Mary how she came to be pregnant, and Joseph didn't believe her when she told him. That's why God had to confirm Mary's story for Joseph.

How shaming for Mary to be thought a little liar as well as a sinful woman! Why would God put Mary through this?

As the First Reading indicates, it helps us to recognize Jesus as Emmanuel—God with us—to know that Jesus did not have a human father; and we are helped towards that view by knowing that Mary was pregnant before she was married.

But why didn't God protect Mary from the shame and suffering of being an unmarried pregnant woman by having the conception of Jesus result from some great public miracle involving Mary, so that everyone knows Mary's pregnancy stems only from the miraculous workings of divine power? God doesn't have to expose Mary to humiliation to make her pregnant, does he?

Well, here's one way to think about the matter. Mary's steadfastness and trust in God even in the trouble of being an unmarried pregnant woman are a training for her and a sign for us, aren't they? Mary will eventually find the greatness of soul to love God and her son at the foot of the cross, in the shame of having her son die a shaming death. And, from watching Mary standing by the cross we learn that human greatness has at its core fidelity through shame and suffering, don't we?

And so, the greatness of Christ on the cross is foreshadowed by the greatness of this small woman, pregnant, shamed, and faithful.

Mensaje del Pastor

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, en la lectura del Evangelio, en un sueño, Dios le dice a José que se case con María, a pesar de que José había descubierto que ella estaba embarazada. Según la ley judía, las relaciones sexuales prematrimoniales se castigan con la muerte; y, en el curso ordinario de las cosas, el embarazo no ocurre sin sexo. Entonces, el embarazo de María fuera del matrimonio la expone a la pena de muerte. Incluso aparte de las sanciones legales, el embarazo de María pone en peligro su desarrollo. Como muestra la propia actitud de José, en la sociedad de María, nadie quiere casarse con una mujer que parece una mujer pecadora y tiene un hijo ilegítimo que mantener.

Es claro, entonces, que el embarazo de María la expone no solo a sanciones legales sino también al sufrimiento y la vergüenza en su sociedad.

Cabe señalar también que José necesita escuchar de Dios mismo que Dios, y ningún hombre, es el padre del hijo de María. Presuntamente, José ya le había preguntado a María cómo quedó embarazada, y José no le creyó cuando se lo dijo. Es por eso que Dios tuvo que confirmar la historia de María para José.

¿Qué vergüenza para María ser considerada una pequeña mentirosa además de una mujer pecadora! ¿Por qué Dios puso a María en esto?

Como indica la Primera Lectura, reconocer a Jesús como Emmanuel —Dios con nosotros— nos ayuda a saber que Jesús no tuvo un padre humano; y nos ayuda a tener ese punto de vista el saber que María estaba embarazada antes de casarse.

Pero ¿por qué Dios no protegió a María de la vergüenza y el sufrimiento de ser una mujer soltera embarazada haciendo que la concepción de Jesús fuera el resultado de algún gran milagro público que involucró a María, para que todos supieran que el embarazo de María proviene solo de la obra milagrosa del poder divino? Y así, la grandeza de Cristo en la cruz es profetizada por la grandeza de esta pequeña mujer, embarazada, avergonzada y fiel.

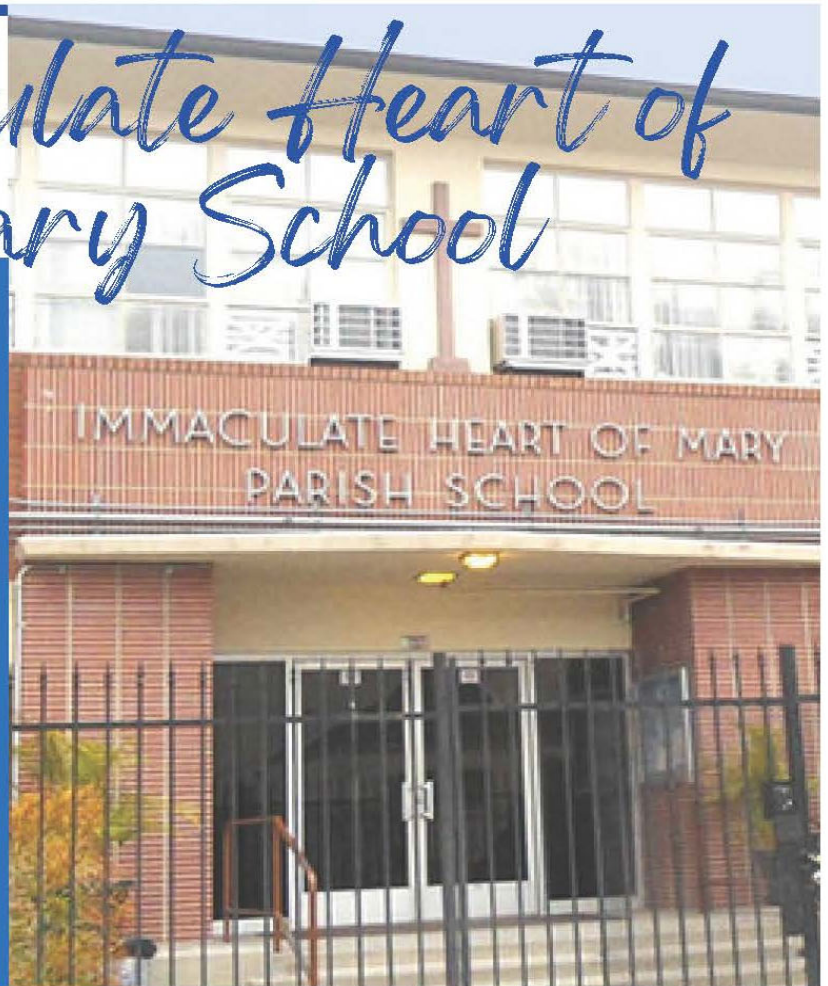

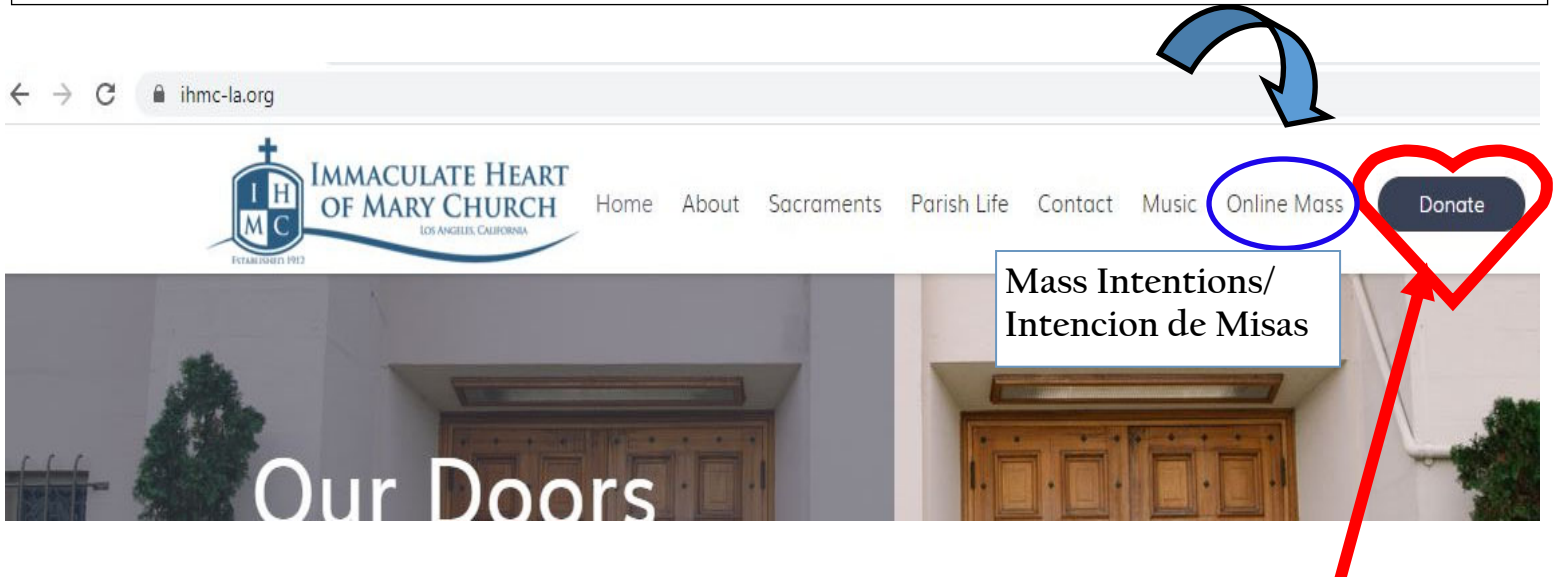

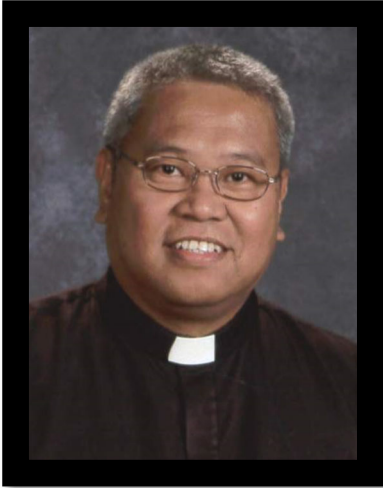
