Associate Pastor Weekly Message

FATHER FLORENTINO B. VICTORINO

2nd SUNDAY IN LENT: MARCH 5, 2023

Today's gospel that talks about the Transfiguration of Jesus explains to us the importance of seeing in him more than a charismatic preacher and noticing that his life and relationships reveal God.

Jesus is human like us. However, his life has the power to change our lives. Saint Paul tells us that all the baptized share equally in the life of the Risen One (Gal. 3, 26-28). This life of Jesus teaches us that, like those invited to be adopted children of God, the Spirit pushes us to organize the world with love and freedom. We must take responsibility for what we do or do not do for the good of others. During his historical life, Jesus does what God expects to see in everyone; the Gospel invites us to be perfect as the Father is perfect (Matthew 5, 48).

This second Lenten Sunday celebrates our community power to choose people who put before us the Christian responsibility of feeding and accompanying each other, and thus sustaining the life and light that society needs.

Baptized as children to be raised in the faith by our parents, or going through the catechumenate as adults, we receive the fullness of the Christian life by being sealed and embraced by the community.

The New Testament documents speak of the early Church with its various ministries, but with one goal. There are a variety of ecclesial models, but only one Spirit. For example, the Church of Corinth had a bishop when Rome had not even thought of that possibility. Corinth followed the ecclesiastical pattern designed by Paul during his missionary visits while Rome counted on the presence of its apostolic guests, the prisoners Peter and Paul, to maintain the close relationship between the Gospel and their local groups similar to our base ecclesial communities.

No one can say for sure how the Church of the future will be organized because it will be something of the Spirit. However, we know that being faithful to Christ requires proclaiming liberation to our neighbor and a better organization of our life in and as Church.

2do DOMINGO DE CUARESMA: 5 DE MARZO, 2023

El evangelio de hoy que habla de la Transfiguración de Jesús nos explica la importancia de ver en él más que un predicador carismático y notar que su vida y relaciones revelan a Dios.

Jesús es humano como nosotros. Sin embargo, su vida tiene fuerza para cambiar nuestras vidas. San Pablo nos dice que todos los bautizados compartimos por igual la vida del Resucitado (Gal. 3, 26-28). Esta vida de Jesús nos enseña que, como los invitados para ser hijos adoptivos de Dios, el Espíritu nos empuja a organizar el mundo con amor y libertad. Debemos responsabilizarnos por lo que hacemos o no hacemos para el bien de los demás. Durante su vida histórica, Jesús hace lo que Dios espera ver en todos; el Evangelio nos invita a ser perfectos como el Padre es perfecto (Mateo 5, 48).

Este segundo domingo cuaresmal celebra el poder comunitario nuestro para escoger a personas quienes nos ponen por delante la responsabilidad cristiana de alimentar y acompañarnos, los unos a los otros, y así sostener la vida y luz que hace falta a la sociedad.

Bautizados como niños para ser criados en la fe por nuestros padres, o pasando por el catecumenado como adultos, recibimos la plenitud de la vida cristiana al ser sellados y abrazados por la comunidad.

Los documentos del Nuevo Testamento hablan de la primera Iglesia con sus diversos ministerios, pero con una sola meta. Hay una variedad de modelos eclesiales, pero un solo Espíritu. Por ejemplo, la Iglesia de Corinto tenía un obispo cuando Roma ni había pensado en esa posibilidad. Corinto seguía el patrón eclesiástico diseñado por Pablo durante sus visitas misioneras mientras que Roma contaba con la presencia de sus huéspedes apostólicos, los prisioneros Pedro y Pablo, para mantener la relación estrecha entre el Evangelio y sus agrupaciones locales semejantes a nuestras comunidades eclesiales de base.

Nadie puede decir con certeza cómo se organizará la Iglesia del futuro porque será algo del Espíritu. Sin embargo, sabemos que ser fiel a Cristo exige proclamar al prójimo la liberación y una mejor organización de nuestra vida en y como Iglesia.

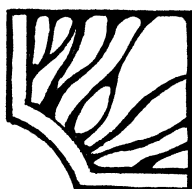
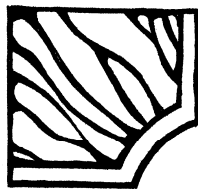

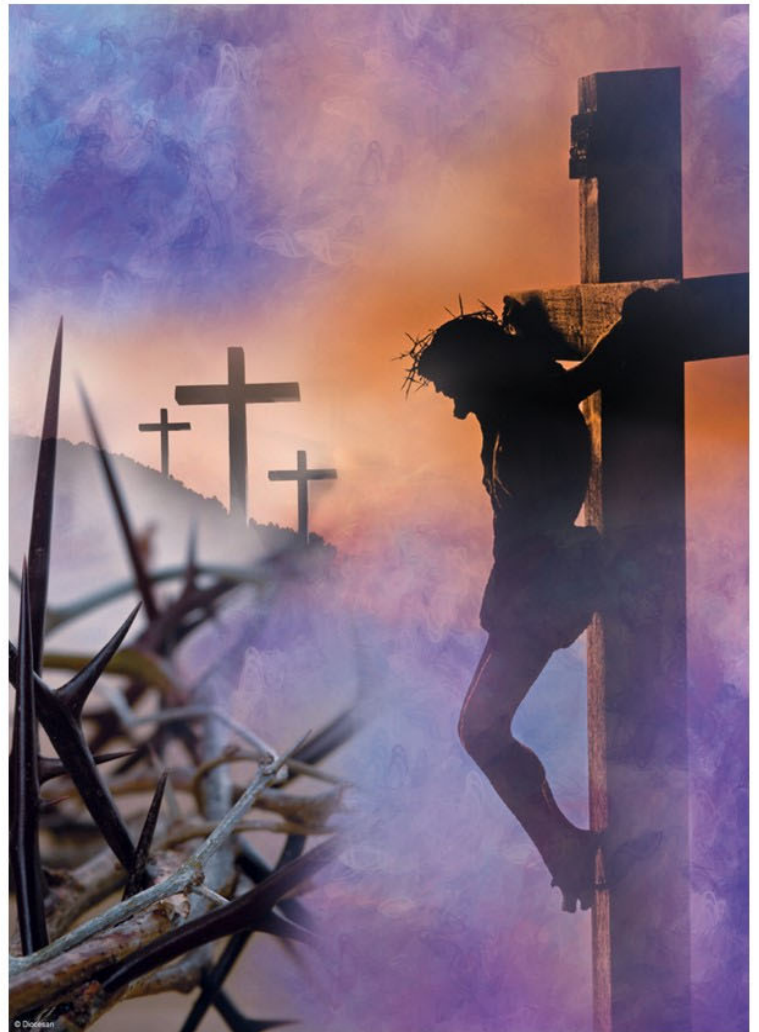

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the **physically or mentally ill** including individuals suffering from **chronic illnesses** such as **diabetes**. Also excluded are **pregnant or nursing women**.

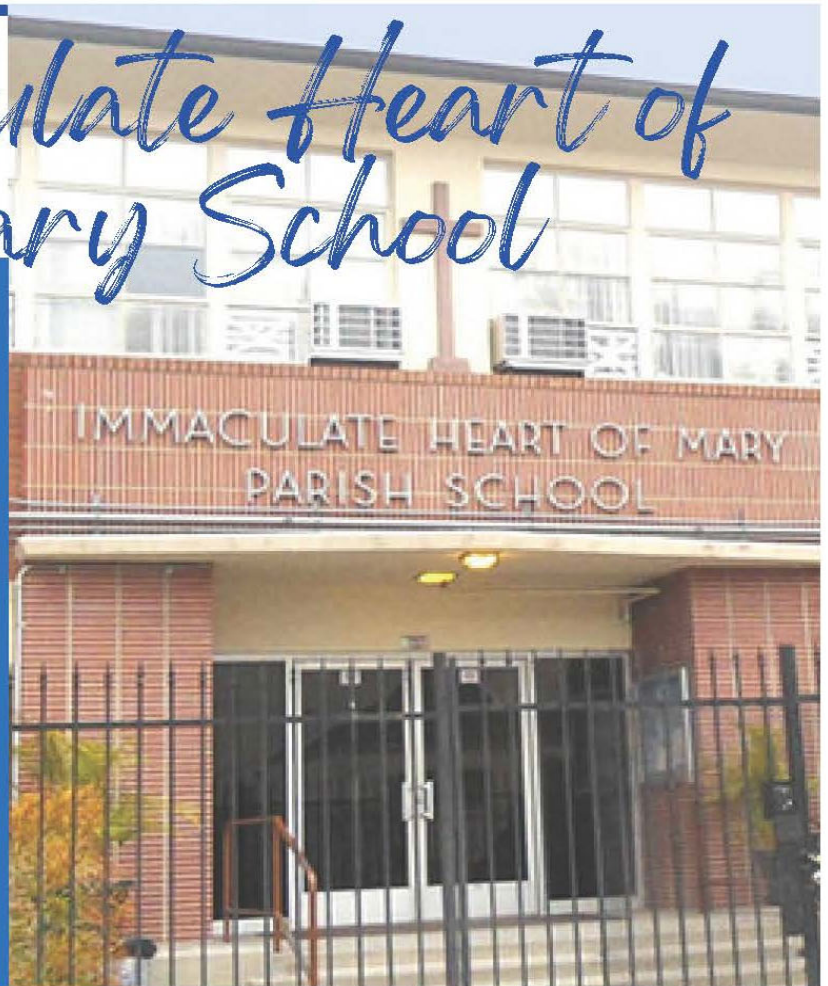

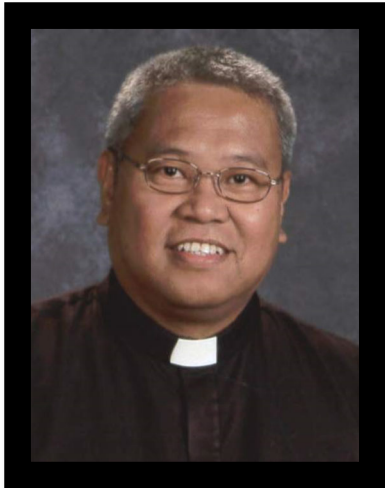
