A note from the Pastor

Reflections, Notes, and Quotes

I was at Walmart the other night and overheard a woman asking one of the young employees where the pool filters were. He hesitated, and said something, and she said to him sharply, "You don't know do you?! I'm used to shopping at Target and people there know where things are ..." I felt sorry for the guy who was the brunt of her unpleasant and rude manners.

Today in Paul's letter to the Corinthians he reminds us how the Law is fulfilled in one statement: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself. But if you go on biting and devouring one another, beware that you are not consumed by one another." Bitterness and rude behavior are not in line with the teachings of Christ. Let us ask the Lord to keep us mindful of the importance of treating one another as we would want to be treated.

Sometimes we don't seem to learn a truth, or correct behavior right away. Sometimes it takes several failed attempts at right behavior and action before we learn a lesson.

It reminds me of the movie Groundhog Day. Bill Murray plays Phil - an arrogant, conceited weather reporter from a TV station who has to cover February 2nd, Groundhog Day in Punxsutawney. While there he is suddenly, consigned to live the same day over and over again for a long time, until he learns some important lessons, which ultimately change him. One of the scenes in the movie is when he crosses a street without looking where he's going and steps in a rut filled with icv. dirty water. Since he has to relive each moment of the day several times, it takes a couple of more times to repeat this when it suddenly occurs to him to jump over the pothole - lesson learned. As he relives the day over and over he learns to treat others with respect and care. For example, in the beginning he treats the TV cameraman, Larry, as if he's an ignorant nobody, by the end he buys him coffee and lets him know what a good person he is.

We don't have the opportunity to change the actions of one moment in time in the way Phil was able to, we live with the consequences and hopefully learn to change our behavior so that we become Christ to one another.

Last weekend was Father's Day and I came across this quip I'd like to share with you:


(A Father's Wisdom) The Barber of Coupe De Ville






