

Once the schedule is ready, you will receive an email alerting you. Once the schedule is set, you will be able to access it at any time online or in the app.

And, if you are interested in volunteering for any of these ministries, please reach out to Ellen and she can help make that happen. We are in need of more volunteers in all our ministries, especially altar servers. The parish provides training for all these ministries. With *Ministry Scheduler Pro*, you will be in control of your availability. This is a prime time to answer the call to ministry in our parish. It would be a great faith-based action to consider for Lent.

As you take "steps forward," your faith in Jesus' true Presence in the Eucharist will grow.



Regulations for Fasting & Abstinence

During the Season of Lent:

- 1. Catholics age 14 and older are to "abstain from meat" on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
- In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics in good health, ages 18 to 59, are to "fast" on <u>Ash Wednesday & Good Friday</u>. Fasting consists of eating only one full meal. Two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal is permitted, if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.


