



June - The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus



The Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

- I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- I will bless every place in which an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.
- I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.

Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Our readings focus on the gifts of the Word of God and the Eucharist. This feast has deep significance to those of us living the stewardship way of life.

Why? As stewards, we recognize that all we are and all gifts are from God. We are to treasure these gifts and use them for God's glory. Our Solemnity today and the readings for this week invite us to more profound gratitude and better stewardship of the two sublime gifts of God's Word and the Eucharist.

In our first reading from Deuteronomy, Our Heavenly Father reminds us that just as we experience physical hunger from lack of food, we become spiritually malnourished through a lack of feeding on the Word of God. It is that important. And, just as the Word of God is vital to our spiritual nourishment, so is the Eucharist's nourishment. Jesus could not make this any more apparent to us: "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you."

Without the Eucharist, we die spiritually. But through the Eucharist, we experience a taste of heaven right now — "Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life."

As Christian stewards, we must recognize that in the gifts of the Word of God and the Eucharist, we have everything we need to sustain us in this world and guide us to heaven. Therefore, let us resolve to always steward these precious gifts well with all our hearts.

Eucharistic Revival - A Minute with Jesus

The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ, Really and Truly Present

The Feast of Corpus Christi celebrates the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At the consecration of every Mass, the priest prays the words which Jesus Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is My Blood." The bread is no longer bread, and the wine is no longer wine. We receive Jesus Himself as nourishment for our souls. This week read these words of Jesus every day: "Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day" (John 6: 54).

Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Corpus Christi Sequence (shortened form)

Lo! the angel's food is given To the pilgrim who has striven; see the children's bread from heaven. which on dogs may not be spent.

Truth the ancient types fulfilling, Isaac bound, a victim willing, Paschal lamb, its lifeblood spilling, manna to the fathers sent.

Very bread, Good Shepherd, tend us, Jesu, of Your love befriend us, You refresh us, You defend us, Your eternal goodness send us In the land of life to see.

You who all things can and know, Who on earth such food bestow. Grant us with Your saints, though lowest, Where the heav'nly feast You show, Fellow heirs and guests to be. Amen. Alleluia.





What Are You Looking For?

The first question that Jesus asks in John's Gospel is, "What are you looking for?" He is speaking to John's disciples as they follow after

Him, desiring to know who Jesus is and what His mission is all about. After the disciples respond, Jesus gives them an instruction, "Come and you will see!" Whether we can hear it or not, that same question is being asked to you. What are YOU looking for? So often, we find ourselves searching, not knowing exactly where to go or what to do in life. We seek things that will hopefully fill the emptiness and longing that we have in our hearts, but nothing seems to satisfy. The real answer to this can be found in Jesus' response as He invites each of us to follow after Him, to get to know Him, and to follow the path He has placed before us. For some men, that path is a very special invitation to walk in Jesus' footsteps as a priest. 


