#### Report of Parish Finances as of June 30, 2025

#### **Summary**

The current financial position of St. Matthew Parish is good. A steady cash flow throughout the year enabled the parish to meet all financial obligations. The Finance and Building & Grounds Councils continue to evaluate all needs resulting in reasonable management of ongoing expenditures.

#### Income

Parish Adult envelopes were down and Offertory was up from the previous year. We also received generous donations toward the new addition and church beautification. Thank you, parishioners, for your continuing support!

#### **Expenses**

For the fiscal year of 2024-2025 we had a credit of \$9,721 toward our subsidy due to SCRIP sales. Utilities including snow removal were down due to easy winter and sale of school.

#### **Financial Position**

As of June 30, 2025, the savings account balance was \$165,626.88 and the checking account balance was \$145,939.78. The Parish also had a balance of \$39,600.87 in our Inspired by the Spirit savings account.

#### **Building Project**

As of June 30, 2025, we had paid \$2,252,198 to Boson Company for work completed.

These funds came from the sale of the school property and the Monsignor McGarty bequest.
