Reflection on Today's Readings Third Sunday of Easter

Today's readings focus on a theme of "sojourning". As Christians, we understand our lives are a journey toward our ultimate destination of heaven.

Our Gospel passage today describes the journey of two disciples on the road to Emmaus. The two are feeling dejected and hopeless after Jesus' death. They knew Jesus personally. They had heard the Gospel message directly from His lips. They heard the testimony of the women who found our Lord's empty tomb and saw angels that announced He was alive. They had been told by other disciples who went to the tomb that everything was just as the women had reported.

How could the Good News be any clearer?

And yet, sometimes, the reactions of the two disciples reflect our own journey, doesn't it? We have the fullness of the Catholic faith, the power of the sacraments, and the support of our parish family. Yet, we often lose our way. We fail to recognize all the gifts we have received. We lack trust in God's perfect goodness and omnipotent power.

But notice what happens to the two men when their eyes are opened once again, and they recognize Jesus in the Eucharist — the "breaking of the bread". They are transformed! Their hearts are set on fire with love for the Lord and their faith. They recall that their hearts began "burning within" as the Lord was explaining the Scriptures to them. When we find we have lost our way, we can turn to the same sources as the two disciples on the road to Emmaus — the Scriptures and the Eucharist.

This Easter season, resolve to feast deeply on these two sources of grace. They are the fuel that will propel us on our journey to heaven.

April 25th

Feast Day of Saint Mark, Evangelist



St Mark is the author of the oldest and shortest Gospel, a companion and assistant to St Paul and St Barnabas and later an "interpreter" for St Peter, and the founder of the Christian Church in Alexandria in Egypt and served as its first bishop. He was martyred in Alexandria in 68 A.D.

He is often symbolized by a winged lion, derived from his description of John the Baptist as a "voice crying out in the desert". He is venerated as the patron saint of Venice, where his relics are housed in St Mark's Basilica.

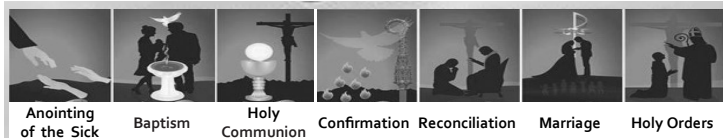

**Eucharistic Revival
A Minute with Jesus**

The Eucharist is the Risen Christ

On Easter Sunday, two disciples were leaving Jerusalem without hope as they believed that the Savior was dead. Jesus joined them as they walked but the disciples did not recognize Him as He now had a glorified body. When Jesus sat down with the disciples at Emmaus, they recognized Him in the "breaking of bread," which was the Eucharist.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

"Lord, make my heart burn with a desire to read Your Word in Sacred Scripture."

This week, read how Jesus explained how He fulfilled the Old Testament in His Passion, Death and Resurrection, and allowed the disciples to recognize Him in the breaking of the bread in Luke 24:13-35.
