Solemnity of the Holy Nativity of the Son of G D



"In the sixth month, the Angel Gabriel was sent from G_D to a town of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary.

Upon arriving, the Angel said to her: Rejoice, O highly favored daughter! The LORD is with you. Blessed are you among women. She was deeply troubled by his words, and wondered what his greeting meant.

The Angel went on to say to her: Do not fear, Mary. You have found favor with G_D. You shall conceive and bear a son and give him the name "Yehušuah" (which is rendered "Jesus.") Great will be His dignity and He will be called Son of the MOST HIGH. The LORD G_D will give Him the throne of David His father. He will rule over the house of Jacob forever and His reign will be without end.

Mary said to the Angel, how can this be since I do not know man The Angel answered her: The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the MOST HIGH will overshadow you; hence, the Holy Offspring to be born will be called Son of G D.

Know that Elizabeth your kinswoman has conceived a son in her old age; she who was thought to be sterile is now in her sixth month, for nothing is impossible with G D.

May said: I am the handmaid of the LORD. Let it be done to me according to your word. With that, the Angel left her." LUKE I: 26 – 38

G_D the Father inhabits light inaccessible. It was to make His Father known to us that Our LORD came on Earth: "No one knows the Father but the Father, and no one known the Father but the Son, and anyone to whom He wishes to reveals Him." -MATT XI: 27.

The Word made flesh is the manifestation of G_D to us. It is G_m made man, showing the Father to us. Therefore, the Christmas Liturgy attaches importance to this manifestation of the Divinity of Christ. Our LORD said: "He who sees me, sees the Father also." – JOHN XIV: 9.
