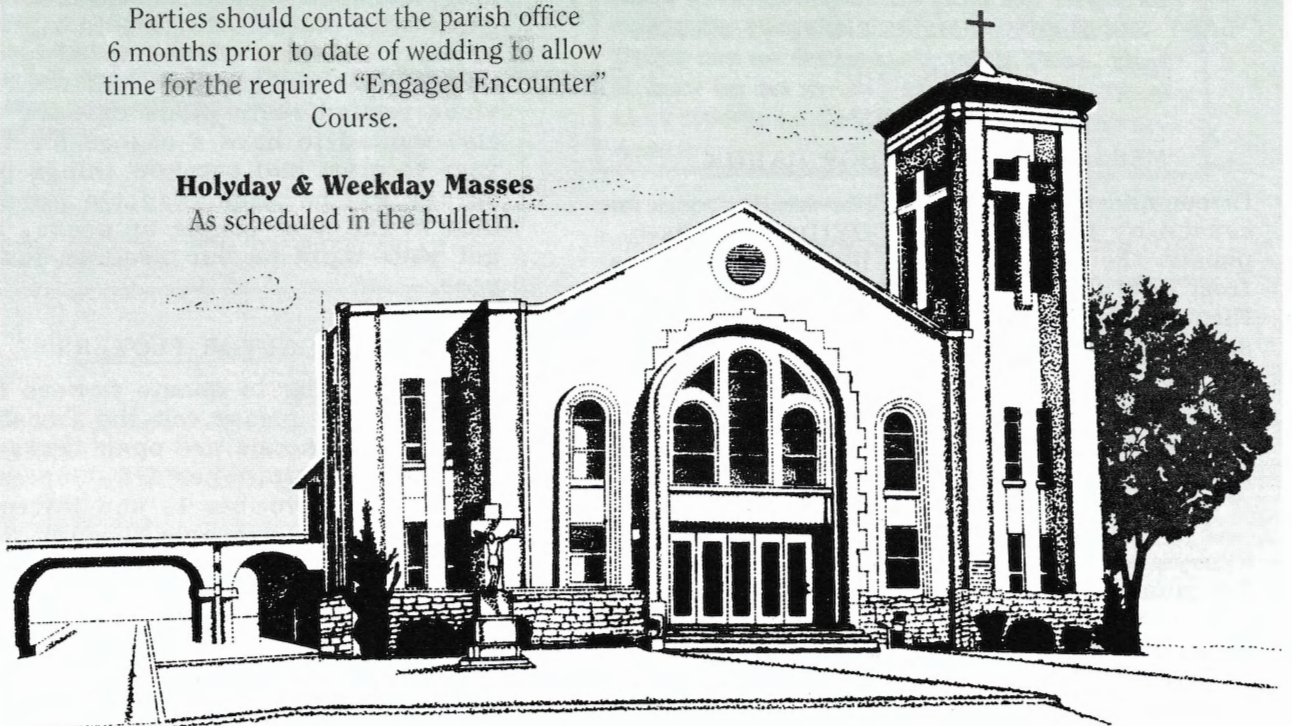

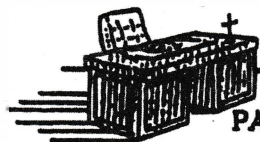

### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK
