**FEAST OF ST. BLAISE**
SATURDAY FEB 3

St. Blaise was a 4th-century bishop. Most of what we know of him comes from legends, particularly the incident when a mother begged him to cure her son, who was dying from a fish bone stuck in his throat. St. Blaise prayed over him, and the boy was healed. St. Blaise was tortured, imprisoned, and eventually beheaded for his Christian belief,

refusing to deny Jesus. By the ninth century, he was invoked for throat ailments, and the blessing of the throat ritual had begun by the 15th century.

St. Rose will offer this blessing at Mass this weekend.
