#### **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The law of **abstinence** obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat. The law of **fast** obliges all those from ages 18 to 59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. *Ages 60 and older are exempt.*
