PARISH HALL ADDITION: The building and finance committees of Saint John Nepomucene have voted to approve an addition to the rear entrance of the parish hall. Our parish hall is used frequently by our parishioners for various events. However, in inclement weather, it becomes quite difficult to fully utilize the kitchen since there is no cover over the back entrance, where people using the hall would normally bring in food and/or decorations. Further, since there is no all-weather surface, any rain causes people coming in the rear entrance to track in mud. Therefore, it was decided to ask for bids to install a cover for the rear entrance area that included a cement surface to make it more convenient for parishioners using the hall. The cost of the project will be approximately \$43,000.
