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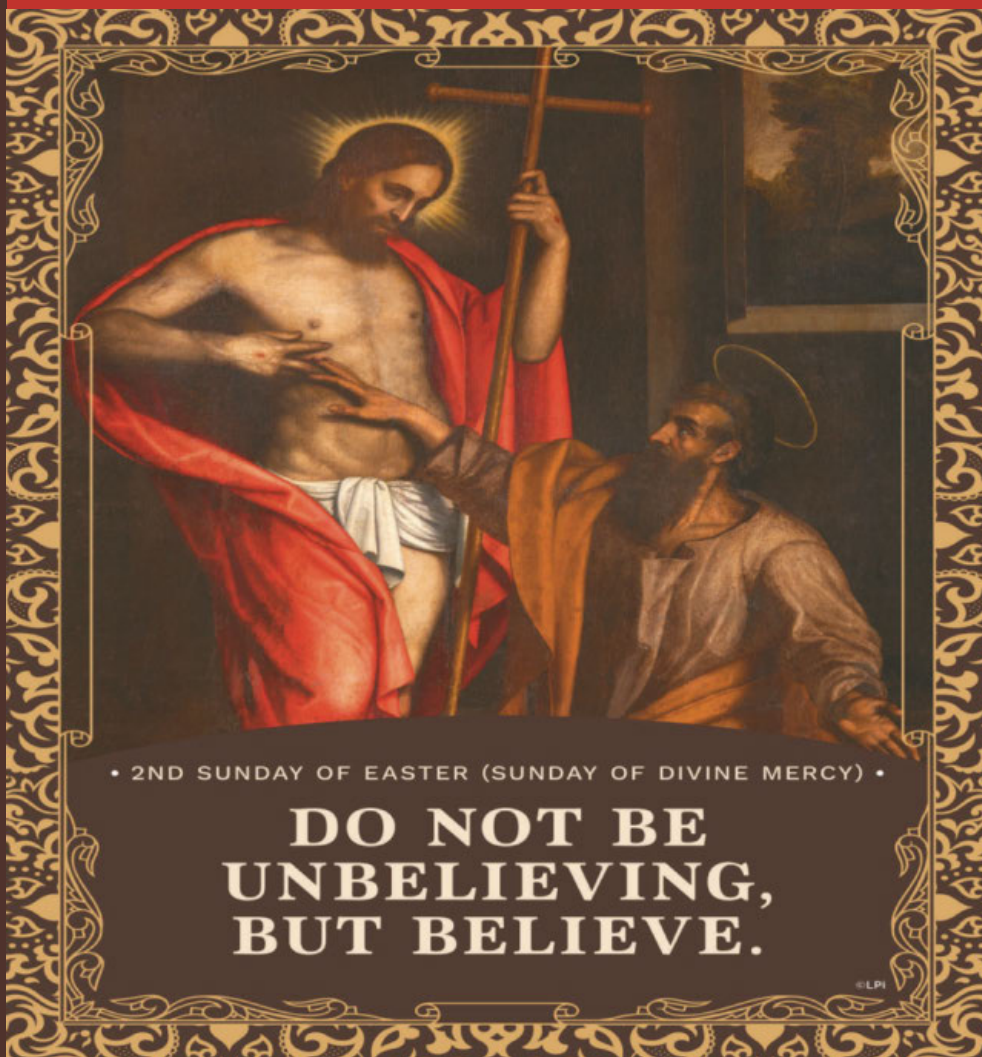

"From the Organ bench..."

"Prayer of St. Francis"

We as Catholics love to party! For us, the great feasts like Christmas and Easter are too great to contain in one single calendar day, so the Church affords us what is called an "Octave". An "Octave" is the 7 (technically 8) day period following Christmas day and Easter day that is considered one long liturgical day. This past week at Daily Mass, we've had two readings before the Gospel, the reading of the Easter Sequence (which we heard sung last Sunday) and the "Glory to God" recited, all very unusual for daily Mass during the rest of the year. This culminates today, Divine Mercy Sunday, which kicks off the rest of the Easter Season concluding on Pentecost on Sunday, June 8th.

Our "Easter Triumph, Easter Joy" has been a little marred this week with the sad news of the passing of our Holy Father, Pope Francis. This is beautifully represented by our Easter Crosses on campus originally draped with white, and now also draped with black during the 9 day mourning period (which concludes on Wednesday). And we entrust our Holy Father to our hope in the Resurrection which we celebrate this season.

In his memory, many Parishes across the World will be programming "Prayer of St. Francis" as part of their music lineup for Sunday Mass today. The hymn "Prayer of St. Francis" was written in 1967 by Sebastian Temple (1928-1997) and has become one of the most famous hymns in the "Folk Mass era" repertoire of Catholic music. Doing a little research, many are shocked to discover that the original text of the "Prayer of St. Francis" most likely was not written by St. Francis of Assisi. Current Scholarship cannot trace the prayer *as we know it today* further back than 1912 when it appeared in a Catholic magazine in France. However, a poem with a striking similarity was written by Giles of Assisi (1190-1262), a close companion of St. Francis of Assisi.

But regardless of its origin, the text provides a great theme for the historic Papacy of Pope Francis and the mission of the wider Church.

May his soul, and all the souls of the faithful departed, through the Mercy of God, rest in Peace!

Christ is Risen! Indeed He is Risen! Alleluia!

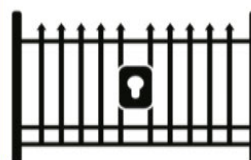

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles has created gardens of healing in each of the Archdiocese's pastoral regions, dedicated to those harmed by sexual abuse, in their family, church or community. Located at St. Camillus Pastoral Center in Boyle Heights (San Gabriel Pastoral Region),

Our Lady of the Assumption Parish in Ventura (Santa Barbara Pastoral Region), St. Francis de Sales Parish in Sherman Oaks (San Fernando Pastoral Region), St. Bernadette Parish in Los Angeles (Our Lady of the Angels Pastoral Region), and Our Lady of Refuge in Long Beach (San Pedro Pastoral Region) these gardens offer a sacred space for all those impacted by abuse to seek comfort and solace.
