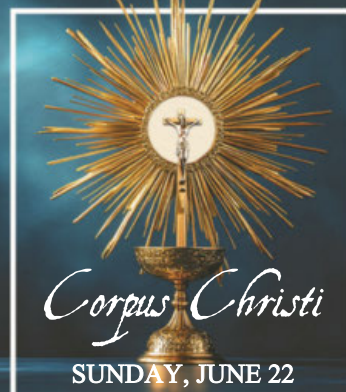

“From the Organ bench...”

"God in three persons, blessed Trinity"

As I've said before in this article, we Catholics love to party! Last weekend was the Solemnity of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church and the conclusion of the Easter season, but not a conclusion of the wider festivities! Today we celebrate one of the central mysteries of the Catholic faith, the most Holy Trinity and next week is the Feast of Corpus Christi.



The declaration of belief in the Trinity came to us from the ecumenical council of Nicea in 325. 1,700 years ago this year. Around that time, a man by the name of Arius incorrectly taught that Christ was *created* and thus not equal to the Father. So the Church in her wisdom convened her first ecumenical council to discuss and later dispute this heretical teaching. Our belief in the Trinity is reflected in many of the prayers we say (like during the Rosary), and many of the hymns we sing.

One of the most famous hymns in honor of the Trinity, if not the most famous is "Holy, Holy, Holy" which is our offertory hymn for 8:00am and 10:00am Mass. The title starts by saying it all! "Holy, Holy, Holy" is the song of the Angels in Isaiah 6:3 and sung at every Mass. As the liner notes from hymnary.org states: *"The words evoke a sense of awe at the majesty of God, and call on all of creation – humans, saints and angels, and all living things – to praise the Godhead three-in-one"*

The text was written by Reginald Herber (1783-1826) a Bishop in the Church of England (the Anglican Church), who wrote this hymn for Trinity Sunday and died contracting a disease while working in India. The tune was written by John B. Dykes (1823-1876) and named the tune every so appropriately "Nicea" after the Council of Nicea.

It is interesting to note the melody of "Nicea" forms the basis of the melody for both the "Glory to God" and "Holy, Holy" for the Heritage Mass, which we are singing at 8:00am and 10:00am Masses until the conclusion of the Liturgical year on November 30th when Advent begins.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit...

DID YOU KNOW?

Body safety information for young children: Children should know the difference between "okay" and "not okay" or "good" and "bad" touches – touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say "no" to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss "safe adults," like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult. 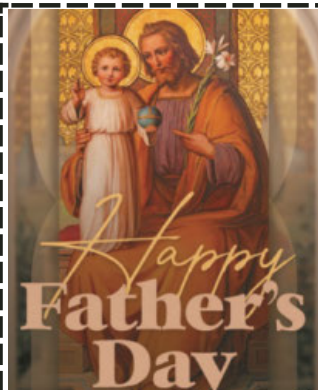

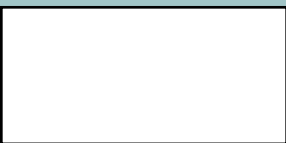
