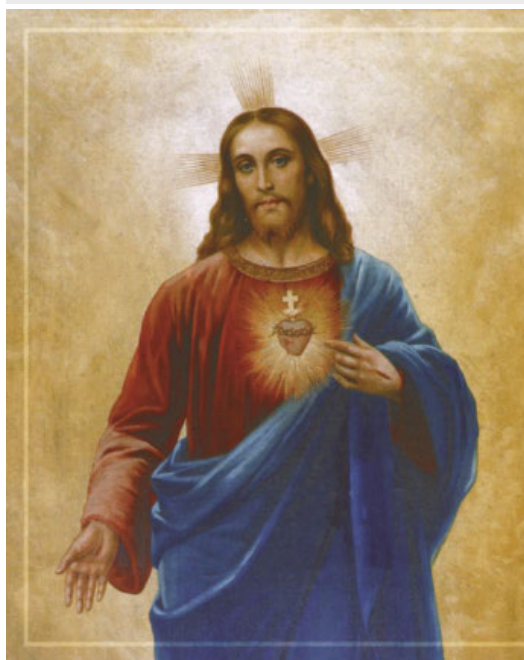

“From the Organ bench...”

“Ave Verum Corpus”

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the most holy Body and Blood of Christ, or the short hand "Corpus Christi". The Feast was established in 1264 by Pope Urban IV, after a Eucharistic miracle the year prior happened where a Priest who had doubted the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist as he was saying Mass. During the Mass, the host started to bleed and the Priest's belief in the Real Presence was renewed.

Lots of the great classics of the cannon of Catholic Sacred Music is centered around the subject of the most Holy Eucharist. One of them we are hearing today is the "Ave Verum Corpus" by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791) arguably his most famous, and widely performed, Sacred work. The text of the "Ave Verum" is attributed to the 13th century and has been used by many different composers (most notably, Mozart, William Byrd and Edward Elgar). Mozart wrote this in 1791 for the neighborhood Parish Church of St. Stephen in Baden (near Vienna, Austria). Mozart (and family) were staying in Baden to "take the waters" (the hot springs) related to various illnesses they were working to recover from. Mozart wrote this while he was working on his most famous opera "The Magic Flute". Mozart, tragically, died less than 6 months after this was written (for the Feast of Corpus Christi). He was 35 years old.

Another one of the classics we are hearing today for offertory at the 8:00am, 10:00am and 12:00pm Masses is the "Panis Angelicus" by Franco-Belgian composer, César Franck (1822-1890). Although Franck is more well known for his Organ musical literature (helping to revolutionize and define the 19th century "French" Organ symphony) like Mozart's "Ave Verum" his "Panis Angelicus" is also widely performed. The text is also from the 13th century and written by St. Thomas Aquinas. Franck was Organist at the Basilica of St. Clotilde from 1859 until his death in 1890.

Explaining sexual abuse to school-aged children: School-aged children should be taught about the dangers of sexual abuse, and the signs of risky situations that could lead to potential abuse. Sexual abuse and exploitation does not only happen through in-person touch; it can happen online or through the phone as well. For this reason, it's important that children know what is and is not okay for adults and others to do. Risky situations can include being asked to send photos, or being contacted by someone you don't know online. 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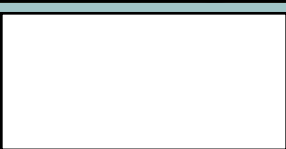
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
