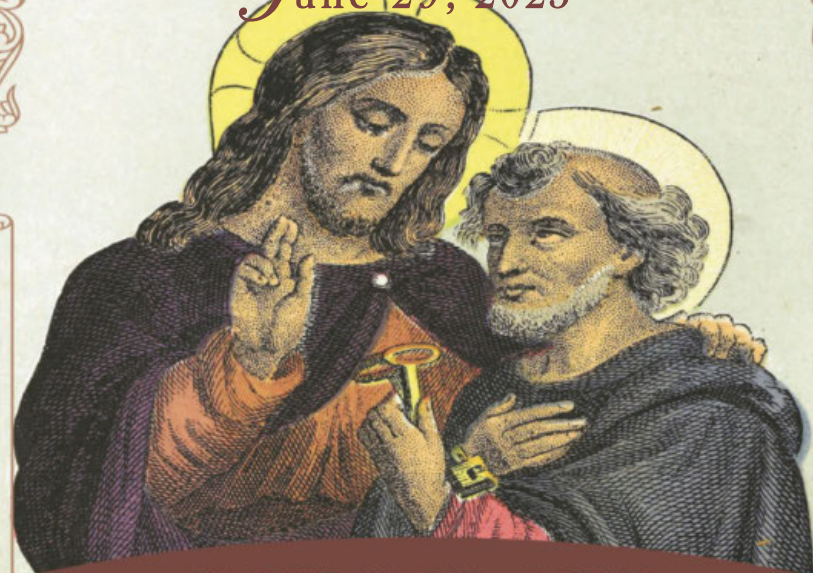

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. In the Gospel, Jesus asks His disciples, “Who do you say that I am?” It’s Peter who boldly proclaims, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” And it is this declaration of faith that becomes the foundation for Peter’s mission and for the Church’s identity. Peter reminds us of the importance of faithfulness, even when we stumble. Paul reminds us of the power of grace, which can transform even the most broken of lives. Together, they show us that God uses real people to spread the Gospel and build up the Church.

This solemnity invites us to reflect on our own calling. How do we respond when Jesus asks, “Who do you say that I am?” Do our lives proclaim Him as Lord? Are we willing to be like St. Peter and St. Paul, speaking the truth, living the Gospel, and letting God work through us? Let us also pray this week for the Church, especially for Pope Leo XIV, the successor of Peter.



"From the Organ bench..."
"God of endings and beginnings"

Today is something of a Liturgical anomaly. Normally the Sunday after the feast of Corpus Christi is a regular Sunday of Ordinary time. But today however, because of how the calendar lines up, we are celebrating the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. A "Solemnity" is a Liturgical day that is extra special, and takes a particular precedence. If a Solemnity falls during the week, the "Glory to God" is recited at Daily Mass and there are two readings before the Gospel, just like at a Sunday Mass (normally there is no "Glory to God" and there is only one reading at Daily Mass). If a Solemnity falls on a Sunday, the proper readings for that Solemnity usually takes precedence over the regular Sunday readings.

You have Solemnities that are particular to each Parish (like the day the Church building was consecrated) Solemnities particular to each Diocese/Archdiocese, and Solemnities particular to the wider Church, like today.

Today also marks something of note for the music ministry. After many months of hard work, today is the last Sunday of the regular Choir "season" for the 10:00am Choir. Although the 10:00am Choir will remain singing at Sunday Mass through July and August, it will be less "formal" then during the regular Choir season until September. You'll be surprised to know, most of the Choir members came into the Choir last October, totally brand new to singing. And we as a group have gone from starting basic hymns to singing works by Mozart and Wesley, and I am very grateful for their hard work. I'd also like to thank the more experienced members of the Choir for their hard work, who have "stuck with it" and provided a foundation upon which to build the Choir we have today. We have lots of exciting things planned for the 2025-2026 season starting in September, and we will have news for you about signups for interested new members in late July/August. If anyone is interested in joining, please email me at justin@sggcatholic.org.

Our 12:00pm Choir on the other hand will remain "in season" during the Summer. But as the 10:00am Choir concludes this leg of the journey, we will be singing a communion meditation named "God of endings and beginnings". Although the tune is familiar to most of you, written in 1966, the lyrics were written just a few years ago by long time Parishioner, Steven Ottományi. The lyrics talk about the God who is with us every step of the way of the Journey of faith, most especially for the endings and beginnings in our lives.

Summer and water safety at home: While parents are often hyper vigilant around pools and lakes, drowning can happen at home in an instant, especially with very young children.
