



"From the Organ bench..."

"Lift High the Cross"

Today, we are hearing lots of hymns about the subject of "The Cross", almost as if we have taken a time machine back to the middle of Lent. But not to worry, this is not the case, it is still July 6th 2025. The reason for a musical "revisit" to the cross is found in today's second reading from St Paul to the Colossians "May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ".

We hear this theme of the Cross in our offertory hymn at 8am and 10am Mass, "Lift High the Cross". This hymn was written by George Kitchin, revised in 1916 by Micheal Newbolt (both Clergymen in the Church of England) with the hymn tune written by Sir Sydney Nicholson. Although the text makes numerous references to different scripture passages about the Cross, the primary source for this text is another letter from St. Paul, this time to the Corinthians which is also appropriate for us to think about today:

"The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God" (Corinthians 1:18).

This hymn is commonly heard during Lent/Holy Week, and also around September 14th, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

A special meditation will also be offered today on the theme of the cross, the old Gospel hymn "At the Cross" written by Russell Kelso Carter (1848-1828), the text of the refrain is as follows:

"At the cross, at the cross where I first saw the light, And the burden of my heart rolled away, It was there by faith I received my sight, And now I am happy all the day!"

May we all have the courage to "Lift High the Cross" in the coming week!
