

A Message from your Pastor Un Mensaje de Su Párraco



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we hear one of the most well-known parables in the Gospels, the Parable of the Good Samaritan. It begins with a simple question: "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus responds with a story that breaks through social, cultural, and religious boundaries. The Samaritan in the parable was the least likely person to stop and help. However, he is the one who shows what true mercy looks like. He sees the wounded man, is moved with compassion, and responds with compassion.

Jesus doesn't just answer the question, He flips it around. Instead of asking, "Who is my neighbor?" He asks, "Which of these three was a neighbor to the man who was hurt?" In other words, being a neighbor isn't about figuring out who deserves our love. Being a neighbor is about becoming the kind of person who shows mercy. Mercy isn't just something we receive from God, it's something we are meant to practice in our daily lives.

As we go through this week, we should reflect on: "Who in my life right now is wounded, forgotten, or ignored?" Jesus is inviting us to go beyond convenience or comfort to respond with compassion to those who are struggling and in need of our help. May the Lord give us eyes to see, hearts to care, and hands to serve.

Este fin de semana escuchamos una de las parábolas más conocidas de los Evangelios, la parábola del buen samaritano. Comienza con una simple pregunta: "¿Quién es mi prójimo?" Jesús responde con una historia que traspasa fronteras sociales, culturales y religiosas. El samaritano de la parábola era la persona que menos probabilidades tenía de detenerse y ayudar. Sin embargo, él es quien muestra cómo es la verdadera misericordia. Ve al hombre herido, se conmueve y responde con compasión.

Jesús no sólo responde la pregunta, sino que le da la vuelta. En lugar de preguntar: "¿Quién es mi prójimo?" Pregunta: "¿Cuál de estos tres era vecino del hombre herido?" En otras palabras, ser prójimo no se trata de descubrir quién merece nuestro amor. Ser prójimo implica convertirse en el tipo de persona que muestra misericordia. La misericordia no es sólo algo que recibimos de Dios, es algo que debemos practicar en nuestra vida diaria.

A medida que avanzamos esta semana, debemos reflexionar sobre: "¿Quién en mi vida está herido, olvidado o ignorado en este momento?" Jesús nos invita a ir más allá de la conveniencia o el confort para responder con compasión a aquellos que están luchando y necesitan nuestra ayuda. Que el Señor nos dé ojos para ver, corazones para cuidar y manos para servir.

"From the Organ bench..."

"Love divine all loves excelling"

We read in the Gospel today:
"You shall love the Lord, your God,
with all your heart,

with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind,

and your neighbor as yourself." (Luke 10:27).

Loving our neighbors as ourselves, that is the operative point of what Our Lord is telling us today in the Gospel. And that is our word of the day, "Love"

We hear this first in the hymn "Love divine, all loves excelling". The lyrics were written by one of the great hymnists of all time, Charles Wesley (1707-1788) with 6,500 titles to his credit. The music (also called the "hymn tune") is called "Hyfrodal" (a Welsh word for "delightful") and was written by Rowland H. Prichard in 1830. This is the same melody used for another other well-known hymn "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus". In singing "Love divine, all loves excelling", we are asking for the Love of God to fill our hearts and our whole person as we gather for Worship this morning. This is rounded out by us being encouraged to take God's love and to share it with others in our hymn of sending forth (also sometimes incorrectly called the "recessional" hymn):

"Go in peace to serve the world, in peace to serve the world. Take the **love** of God, the **love** of God with you as you go".

And as the Gospel tells us, we show that "Love divine..." by engaging in Christ like service to others.




