To enroll in the preschool program, your child must be four years old by Sept. 1, 2023. **When you register your students, please pay for them as it makes the bookkeeping a lot easier.** The cost for the CCD & CYO program per family is \$45.00 for 1 student, \$90.00 for 2 students, \$135.00 for 3 students and \$160.00 for 4 or more students. Students are in the same grade in CCD & CYO as they are in school.
