

Ask Mary to intercede for the world and for your own intentions.




WE HAVE A POPE, HIS HOLINESS POPE LEO XVI

“Peace be with you, God loves all”: Leo XIV’s embrace of the world.

From the Loggia of Blessings in St. Peter's Basilica, the first appearance of Robert Francis Prevost, until now Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops, elected by the Cardinals in the Conclave as the 267th Pontiff of the Universal Church. Hymns, songs, prayers, applause, shouts of "Long live the Pope!" and exclamations of joy accompanied the announcement of the Habemus Papam by the 100,000 people present.

First, the name: Leo XIV, in memory of Leo XIII. Then, the face: the expression of serenity and wonder of someone who, for the first time, with new clothes and a renewed outlook, experiences firsthand what his predecessors experienced in that first greeting from the Lodge of Blessings. Shouts, songs, applause, cheers of "Long live the Pope!" and "Leo, Leo!" banners, flags, and telephone lights shining under the Roman sky slowly entering twilight. And finally, the words: the first words spoken with a firm voice and a Spanish accent:

“Peace be with you all! Dearest brothers and sisters, this is the first greeting of the Risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who gave his life for the flock of God. I too would like this greeting of peace to enter your hearts, to reach your families, to all people, wherever they may be, to all nations, to the whole earth. Peace be with you!”



Let us pray for our Sovereign Pontiff, Pope Leo XIV.

May the Lord preserve him, give him a long life, make him blessed upon the earth, and not hand him over to the power of his enemies. May your hand be upon your holy servant. And upon your son, whom you have anointed

TEMENOS PAPA, SU SANTIDAD PAPA LEÓN XIV

**“La paz esté con ustedes,
Dios ama a todos”:
el abrazo de León XIV al mundo.**

Desde la Logia de las Bendiciones de la Basílica de San Pedro, la primera aparición de Robert Francis Prevost, hasta ahora prefecto del Dicasterio para los Obispos, elegido por los cardenales en el Cónclave como el 267.º Pontífice de la Iglesia universal. Himnos, cantos, oraciones, aplausos, vítores de “¡Viva el Papa!” y exclamaciones de júbilo acompañaron el anuncio del Habemus Papam por parte de las cien mil personas presentes.

Primero, el nombre: León XIV, en memoria de León XIII, Luego, el rostro: la expresión de serenidad y asombro de quien, por primera vez, con vestiduras nuevas y una mirada renovada, experimenta en carne propia lo que sus predecesores vivieron en aquel primer saludo desde la Logia de las Bendiciones. Gritos, cantos, aplausos, vítores de «¡Viva el Papa!» y «¡León, León!», pancartas, banderas, luces de teléfonos que brillan bajo el cielo romano que lentamente entra en el crepúsculo. Y, por último, las palabras: las primeras palabras pronunciadas con voz firme y acento español:

“¡La paz esté con todos ustedes! Queridísimos hermanos y hermanas, este es el primer saludo de Cristo Resucitado, el Buen Pastor que dio la vida por el rebaño de Dios. También yo quisiera que este saludo de paz entrara en sus corazones, llegara a sus familias, a todas las personas, dondequiera que estén, a todos los pueblos, a toda la tierra. ¡La paz esté con ustedes!”
