COME, HOLY SPIRIT, FILL THE HEARTS OF YOUR FAITHFUL

Message of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI, Sunday, 31 May 2009

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today the Church throughout the world is reliving the Solemnity of Pentecost, the mystery of her birth, her own "Baptism" in the Holy Spirit (cf. Acts 1:5) which occurred in Jerusalem 50 days after Easter, precisely on the Jewish Feast of Pentecost. The Risen Jesus had told his disciples: "Stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high" (Lk 24:49). This actually happened in the Upper Room, while they were all gathered in prayer with Mary, the Virgin Mother. As we read in the Acts of the Apostles, that place was suddenly filled with the rush of a mighty wind and tongues as of fire settled on each one of those present. The Apostles then went out and began to proclaim in different languages that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, dead and risen (cf. Acts 2:1-4). The Holy Spirit, who with the Father and the Son, created the universe, who guided the People of Israel through history and spoke through the Prophets, who in the fullness of time cooperated in our redemption, came down at Pentecost upon the nascent Church and made her missionary, sending her out to proclaim to all peoples the victory of divine love over sin and death.

The Holy Spirit is the soul of the Church. Without him what would she be reduced to? She would certainly be an important movement in history, a complex and solid social institution, perhaps a sort of humanitarian agency. And to tell the truth she is considered such by those who do not see her from a perspective of faith. Yet, the reality is that in her true



nature and also in her authentic presence in history, the Church is ceaselessly formed and guided by the Spirit of her Lord. She is a living body, whose vitality is, precisely, the fruit of the invisible divine Spirit.

Dear friends, this year the Solemnity of Pentecost occurs on the last day of the month of May on which the beautiful Marian feast of the Visitation is normally celebrated.

This fact invites us to let ourselves be inspired and, as it were, instructed by the Virgin Mary, who was the protagonist of both these events. In Nazareth she received the announcement of her unique motherhood and, immediately after conceiving Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit, she was impelled by the same Spirit of love to go and help her elderly kinswoman Elizabeth, who had reached the sixth month of a pregnancy that was also miraculous. The young Mary who is carrying Jesus in her womb and, forgetting herself, hurries to the help of her neighbour, is a wonderful image of the Church in the perennial youthfulness of the Spirit, of the missionary

Church of the incarnate Word called to bring him to the world and to witness to him especially in the service of charity. Let us therefore invoke the intercession of Mary Most Holy, so that she may obtain for the Church of our time that she be powerfully strengthened by the Holy Spirit. In particular, may the ecclesial communities that are suffering persecution in Christ's name feel the comforting presence of the Paraclete so that, participating in her suffering, they may receive the spirit of glory in abundance (cf. 1 Pt 4:13-14).

VEN, ESPÍRITU SANTO, LLENA LOS CORAZONES DE TUS FIELES

Mensaje de Su Santidad el Papa Benedicto XVI Domingo 31 de mayo de 2009

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

La Iglesia esparcida por el mundo entero revive hoy, solemnidad de Pentecostés, el misterio de su nacimiento, de su "bautismo" en el Espíritu Santo (cf. Hch 1, 5), que tuvo lugar en Jerusalén cincuenta días después de la Pascua, precisamente en la fiesta judía de Pentecostés. Jesús resucitado había dicho a sus discípulos: "Permaneced en la ciudad hasta que seáis revestidos de poder desde lo alto" (Lc 24, 49). Esto aconteció de forma sensible en el Cenáculo, mientras se encontraban todos reunidos en oración junto con María, la Virgen Madre.

Como leemos en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, de repente aquel lugar se vio invadido por un viento impetuoso, y unas lenguas como de fuego se posaron sobre cada uno de los presentes. Los Apóstoles salieron entonces y comenzaron a proclamar en diversas lenguas que Jesús es el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, que murió y resucitó (cf. Hch 2, 1-4). El Espíritu Santo, que con el Padre y el Hijo creó el universo, que guió la historia del pueblo de Israel y habló por los profetas, que en la plenitud de los tiempos cooperó a nuestra redención, en Pentecostés bajó sobre la Iglesia naciente y la hizo misionera, enviándola a anunciar a todos los pueblos la victoria del amor divino sobre el pecado y sobre la muerte.

El Espíritu Santo es el alma de la Iglesia. Sin él, ¿a qué se reduciría? Ciertamente, sería un gran movimiento histórico, una institución social compleja y sólida, tal vez una especie de agencia humanitaria. Y en verdad es así como la consideran quienes la ven desde fuera de la perspectiva de la fe. Pero, en realidad, en su



verdadera naturaleza y también en su presencia histórica más auténtica, la Iglesia es plasmada y guiada sin cesar por el Espíritu de su Señor. Es un cuerpo vivo, cuya vitalidad es precisamente fruto del Espíritu divino invisible.

Queridos amigos, este año la solemnidad de Pentecostés cae en el último día del mes de mayo, en el que habitualmente se celebra la hermosa fiesta mariana de la Visitación. Este hecho nos invita a dejarnos inspirar y, en cierto modo, instruir por la Virgen María, la cual fue protagonista de ambos acontecimientos. En Nazaret ella recibió el anuncio de su singular maternidad e, inmediatamente después de haber concebido a Jesús por obra del Espíritu Santo, fue impulsada por el mismo Espíritu de amor a acudir en ayuda de su anciana prima Isabel, que ya se encontraba en el sexto mes de una gestación también prodigiosa. La joven María, que, llevando en su seno a Jesús y olvidándose de sí misma, acude en ayuda del prójimo, es icono estupendo de la Iglesia en la perenne juventud del Espíritu, de la Iglesia misionera del Verbo encarnado, llamada a llevarlo al mundo y a testimoniarlo especialmente en el servicio de la caridad.

Invoquemos, por tanto, la intercesión de María santísima, para que obtenga a la Iglesia de nuestro tiempo la gracia de ser poderosamente fortalecida por el Espíritu Santo. Que sientan la presencia consoladora del Paráclito en especial las comunidades eclesiales que sufren persecución por el nombre de Cristo, para que, participando en sus sufrimientos, reciban en abundancia el Espíritu de la gloria (cf. 1 P 4, 13-14).
