



MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS BENEDICT XVI SUNDAY, 8 JULY 2007


The Gospel today (cf. Lk 10: 1-12, 17-20) presents Jesus sending out 72 disciples to the villages he is about to visit in order to prepare the way. This is a particular feature of the Evangelist Luke, who stressed that the mission was not exclusive to the Twelve Apostles but extended also to the other disciples. Indeed, Jesus said: "The harvest is plentiful but the labourers are few" (Lk 10: 2). There is work for all in God's field. Christ, however, did not limit himself to sending out his missionaries: he also gave them clear and precise instructions on how to behave. He first sent them out "two by two" so that they might help each other and bear witness to brotherly love. He warned them that they would be like "lambs in the midst of wolves". They were to be peaceful in spite of everything, and were to bear a message of peace in every situation; they were not to take clothes or money with them in order to live on whatever Providence offered them; they were to heal the sick as a sign of God's mercy; wherever people rejected them, they were to depart, doing no more than to alert them to their responsibility for rejecting the Kingdom of God. St Luke highlighted the disciples' enthusiasm at the good results of their mission and recorded Jesus' beautiful expression: "Do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you; but rejoice that your names are written in heaven" (Lk 10: 20).
May this Gospel reawaken in all the baptized the awareness that they are missionaries of Christ, called to prepare the way for him with words and with the witness of their lives.

It is vacation time and tomorrow I am leaving for Lorenzago di Cadore, where I shall be a guest of the Bishop of Treviso in the house in which the venerable John Paul II used to stay. The mountain air will do me good and I shall be able - I hope so - to dedicate myself more freely to reflection and prayer. I hope everyone, especially those in greatest need, will be able to take a bit of vacation to restore their physical and spiritual energy and recover a healthy contact with nature. The mountains call to mind in particular the spirit's ascent towards the heavens, its uplifting towards the "high standard" of our humanity, which daily life unfortunately tends to debase. In this regard, I would like to recall the fifth pilgrimage of young people to the Cross on Mount Adamello, which the Holy Father John Paul II visited twice. The pilgrimage has been taking place in these days and has just culminated in Holy Mass, celebrated at an altitude of 3,000 meters. As I greet the Archbishop of Trent and the General Secretary of the Italian Bishops' Conference, as well as the Authorities of Trent, I remind all young Italians of their appointment in Loreto on 1-2 September.
May the Virgin Mary protect us always, both in our mission and in well-deserved rest, so that we may joyfully and fruitfully carry out our work in the Lord's vineyard.



MENSAJE DE SU SANTIDAD EL PAPA BENEDICTO XVI DOMINGO 8 DE JULIO DE 2007

El evangelio de hoy (cf. Lc 10, 1-12. 17-20) presenta a Jesús que envía a setenta y dos discípulos a las aldeas a donde está a punto de ir, para que preparen el ambiente. Esta es una particularidad del evangelista san Lucas, el cual subraya que la misión no está reservada a los doce Apóstoles, sino que se extiende también a otros discípulos.

En efecto, Jesús dice que "la mies es mucha, y los obreros pocos" (Lc 10, 2). En el campo de Dios hay trabajo para todos. Pero Cristo no se limita a enviar: da también a los misioneros reglas de comportamiento claras y precisas. Ante todo, los envía "de dos en dos" para que se ayuden mutuamente y den testimonio de amor fraterno. Les advierte que serán "como corderos en medio de lobos", es decir, deberán ser pacíficos a pesar de todo y llevar en todas las situaciones un mensaje de paz; no llevarán consigo ni alforja ni dinero, para vivir de lo que la Providencia les proporcione; curarán a los enfermos, como signo de la misericordia de Dios; se irán de donde sean rechazados, limitándose a poner en guardia sobre la responsabilidad de rechazar el reino de Dios.

San Lucas pone de relieve el entusiasmo de los discípulos por los frutos de la misión, y cita estas hermosas palabras de Jesús: "No os alegréis de que los espíritus se os sometan; alegraos, más bien, de que vuestros nombres estén escritos en los cielos" (Lc 10, 20).

Ojalá que este evangelio despierte en todos los bautizados la conciencia de que son misioneros de Cristo, llamados a prepararle el camino con sus palabras y con el testimonio de su vida.

Es tiempo de vacaciones y mañana partiré para Lorenzago di Cadore, donde seré huésped del obispo de Treviso en la casa que ya acogió al venerado Juan Pablo II. El aire de montaña me hará bien —así lo espero— y podré dedicarme más libremente a la reflexión y a la oración.

Deseo a todos, especialmente a los que sienten mayor necesidad, que puedan tomar vacaciones, para reponer las energías físicas y espirituales, y renovar un contacto saludable con la naturaleza. La montaña, en particular, evoca la elevación del espíritu hacia las alturas, hacia el "grado alto" de nuestra humanidad que, por desgracia, la vida diaria tiende a rebajar.

A este propósito, quiero recordar la V Peregrinación de los jóvenes a la cruz del Adamello, a donde el Santo Padre Juan Pablo II fue dos veces. La peregrinación se realizó durante estos días, y acaba de culminar con la santa misa, celebrada aproximadamente a tres mil metros de altura. A la vez que saludo al arzobispo de Trento y al secretario general de la Conferencia episcopal italiana, así como a las autoridades trentinas, renuevo la cita a todos los jóvenes italianos para los días 1 y 2 de septiembre en Loreto.

Que la Virgen María nos proteja siempre, tanto en la misión como en el merecido descanso, para que podamos realizar con alegría y con fruto nuestro trabajo en la viña del Señor.
