



## Diocesan Updates for Attending Mass as of June 20, 2021

Please see below new updates from the Roman Catholic Diocese of Portland Maine on the gradual lifting of COVID-19 restrictions for Mass and other liturgical celebrations over the summer to be in fully implemented by August 1, 2021.



**Catholics will once again be obligated to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days beginning on the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 19-20, Fathers' Day Weekend.**

We will continue:

- No face masks or social distancing required
- Live-stream Mass for those who cannot be present.
- Have sanitizer available at the entrances of the church and at communion stations.
- No physical exchange of the sign of peace.
- No distribution of the Precious Blood

We will begin to implement the following between now and August 1:

- Clear out accumulated chairs, tables, cleaning supplies, posters, displays, etc. related to the pandemic from the narthex, reconciliation room, and other areas of the church.
- Make available printed materials (hymnals, bulletins, lectionaries flyers) etc.
- Make holy water available at entrances.
- Resume the entrance procession, the Gospel procession, collections of the offerings and offertory and recessional processions.
- No Recitation of the Act of Spiritual Communion during Mass.
- Distribute Holy Eucharist in the usual procession toward designated communion stations. No social distancing is required.
- Lift any liturgical restrictions for Rite of baptism of infants, weddings, and funerals that have been in place due to COVID-19.
- Resume use of confessionals and reconciliation rooms.

In addition:

- Staff and volunteers must treat the vaccinated and unvaccinated equally.
- Treat those wearing masks and those not wearing masks equally.
- Anyone is free to wear a mask if he or she wishes.
- It is recommended that those not vaccinated wear a mask.
- If the parish makes socially distanced-seating available, it cannot determine who sits in that seating.

The livestreamed Masses will also be viewable for a short time in the archive area afterwards, which is the second video on that page. The most recent Mass will be up front, while a blue "Playlist" tab in upper right corner will give a list of recent additional archived Masses.

# New Steeple Installed at St. Mary of the Isles in Islesboro

ISLESBORO---Thanks to the help of inspired congregants and staff at St. Brendan the Navigator Parish in Camden, St. Mary of the Isles Church in Islesboro now has a new steeple.

“Steeple represent an important part of the history and culture of most small towns in Maine,” said Karol Skoby, business coordinator at St. Brendan the Navigator Parish. “But few architectural elements are more exposed to threats than steeples.”

The damage that can be caused by wind, moisture, lightning, age, and deferred maintenance can require considerable funds for repair.

In 2007, the Maine Steeples Fund was established to support local efforts to restore church steeples of historic, cultural, and community significance in small cities and towns in Maine.

“The fund offers assessment grants and restoration grants,” said Ruth Demers of Maine Steeples Fund. “As long as you are a nonprofit entity or municipality, you can apply for funds.”

With the help of Karol and Art Govoni, the caretaker and project coordinator, congregants Lila White and Lee and Diane Fentress applied for a grant from the Maine Steeples Fund, submitting a description of the work to be done and a history of St. Mary of the Isles, which hosted its first Mass in 1901. The group then worked with an assessor to determine the scope and estimated cost of the restoration. The Maine Steeples Fund matches funds raised by the applicant.

## ST. MARY OF THE ISLES

St Mary’s of the Isles is a Roman Catholic Church, located on the island of Islesboro. It currently functions as a mission or seasonal church during the months of June-September, providing weekly Mass at 9:00am on Saturdays. St Mary’s is one of the 7 churches which comprise the Parish of St Brendan the Navigator. All other services such as weddings, funerals and appointments with priests are arranged through the Parish Office at 7 Union Street in Camden, 207-236-4785.



St Mary’s community is warm and welcoming to all who wish to attend. The community is a diverse one which includes people from all walks of life as well as different parts of the world. The church family assumes responsibility for the maintenance of the church and its property, however, the church is governed as part of St Brendan the Navigator and then ultimately the Roman Catholic Bishop Portland.




“Ultimately, St. Mary received a \$21,625 grant,” said Skoby. “The balance of the cost of repairs was underwritten by private donations.”

The work was extensive as the steeple needed reconstruction from the belfry up. The cross was still in good condition but received a re-framing. The work was done by DICON, the restoration and construction company of the Diocese of Portland which maintains and enhances over 400 structures in Maine.

St. Mary of the Isles Church, located on Pendleton Point Road, will reopen on July 3 for Masses on Saturdays at 9:00 a.m.






