



ST. ANDREW DUNG-LAC AND COMPANIONS FEAST DAY: NOVEMBER 24TH

Andrew Dung-Lac, a Catholic convert ordained to the priesthood, was one of 117 people martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. Members of the companions group gave their lives for Christ in the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries, and received beatification during four different occasions between 1900 and 1951. All were canonized during the papacy of Saint John Paul II. Christianity came to Vietnam through the Portuguese. Jesuits opened the first permanent mission at Da Nang in 1615. They ministered to Japanese Catholics who had been driven from Japan. During the six decades after 1820, between 100,000 and 300,000 Catholics were killed or subjected to great hardship. Foreign missionaries martyred in the first wave included priests of the Paris Mission Society, and Spanish Dominican priests and tertiaries. In 1832, Emperor Minh-Mang banned all foreign missionaries, and tried to make all Vietnamese deny their faith by trampling on a crucifix. Like the priest

-holes in Ireland during English persecution, many hiding places were offered in homes of the faithful. Persecution broke out again in 1847, when the emperor suspected foreign missionaries and Vietnamese Christians of sympathizing with a rebellion led by of one of his sons. The last of the martyrs were 17 laypersons, one of them a 9-year-old, executed in 1862. That year a treaty with France guaranteed religious freedom to Catholics, but it did not stop all persecution.

WINDOW DRESSERS UPDATE & NEED VOLUNTEERS through November 24

The Belfast Build of Window Dressers is on through November 24, and taking place at the Belfast Boathouse. Vaccinations and masks are required for the safety of all. You can sign up at: Window Dressers.org/community build/Belfast.

Our Parish continues to keep people warmer, reduce fuel bills and decrease carbon levels by constructing WindowDressers indoor window inserts that keep the cold out! Our parish supports this program by participating as volunteers at both the Searsport and Belfast build.

In the past volunteers also participated in Rockland when the build was located at Lincoln Street. Due to Covid, all Maine Community builds were cancelled in 2020. But, this year with special precautions, WindowDressers managed to organize 30 community builds through out the state. The numbers of inserts were reduced to ensure volunteers remained safe. And despite this

requirement, the Belfast and Searsport volunteers managed to build over 500 inserts! 25% were provided to families who otherwise could not afford to buy them.

It was wonderful getting together to do something important for others and to know this program really makes a difference for so many. We were delighted that Fr. Divine participated. He didn't just watch! He was one of the best wrappers we ever had! Kevin Michaud deserves special recognition too. Kevin volunteers every day at both Builds and his contribution is invaluable! Many thank-yous to all who participated.

AT ST. FRANCIS: A reminder for Belfast that when it snows, parking on all blocks in the vicinity of the church must be on **one side only**—for Court Street it is the NE side (opposite the church). On Elm, Park, and Grove it is the first parker who sets the side... This is to allow emergency vehicles access on our narrow streets.


