## RACHEL'S VINEYARD RETREAT, APR. 22-24 TO LEAD ALL THOSE HURTING FROM ABORTION ON A PATH TO HEALING

PORTLAND, Feb. 14th---Feelings of hurt, emptiness, and regret often impact not only women who get abortions, but their spouses, parents, grandparents, and friends.

Rachel's Vineyard retreats aim to offer solace, peace, and inner healing to any individual connected to an abortion, regardless of the role they played. The retreat provides a safe place to grieve the loss and to understand how abortion has affected them, so they can grow beyond it.

"We know abortion can cause intense emotional and spiritual pain. At Project Rachel, we do not judge or condemn," said Judy Shaw, an organizer of the retreats.

The next Rachel's Vineyard retreat in Maine will be held on **April 22-24 in southern Maine starting on Friday at 6pm and concluding on Divine Mercy Sunday at 1:30 pm.** The weekend will include Scripture meditations, the opportunity for the sacrament of reconciliation, a memorial service, Mass, and sharing with others personally affected by abortion.

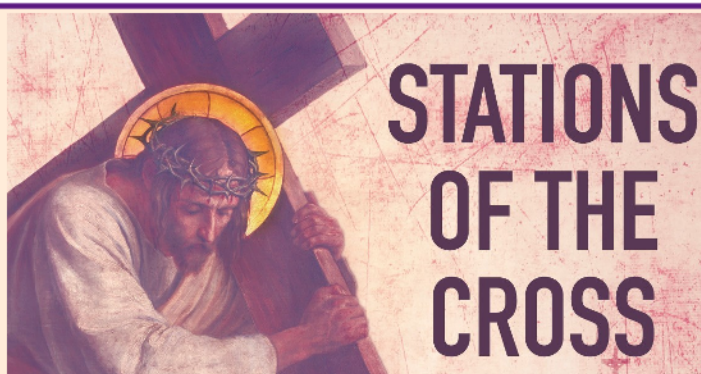

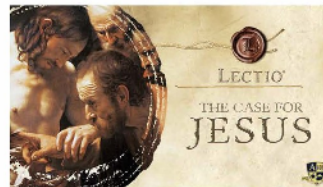

**Sacrament of Reconciliation:** Available during the half -hour before every weekend Mass or by appointment.

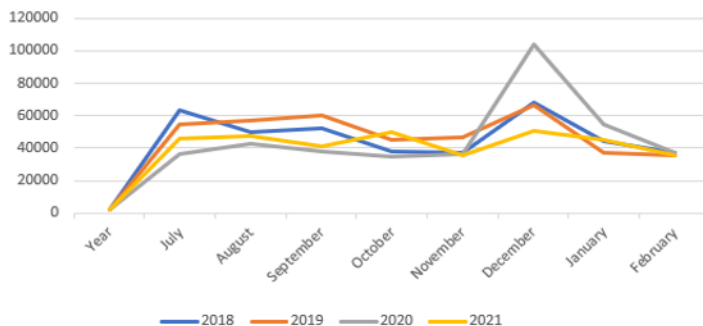
