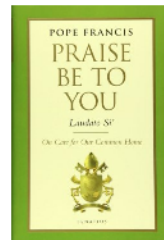

WHAT WILL YOU FIND IN LAUDATO SI?

Words from Pope Francis: Number 16 from the Encyclical:

“...Each Chapter will have its own subject and specific approach, it will also take up and re-examine the important questions previously dealt with (in the introduction of the Encyclical). This is particularly the case with a number of themes which appear as the Encyclical unfolds. As examples, I will point out the intimate relationship between the poor and the fragility of the planet...”



The St Francis committee has been sharing their personnel reflections weekly in the bulletin. We would now like to encourage more parishioners to join us in reading and reflecting on the encyclical. Starting this week we hope that parishioners will follow along with us by reading the *Laudato Si'* encyclical and focus on the week's reflection.

Ten copies of *Laudato Si* were made available in the hall of the church two weeks ago, and since I do not see them on the table, we hope they are being read! 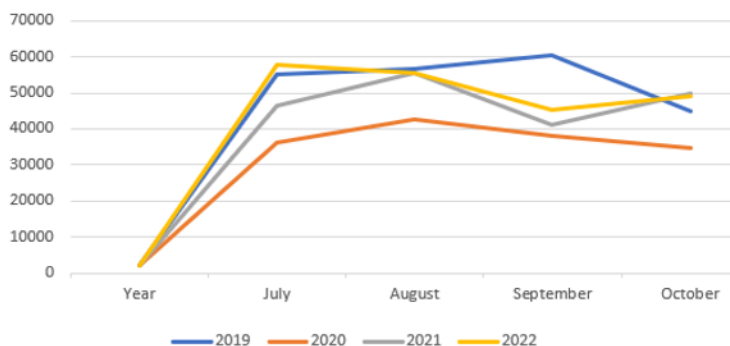

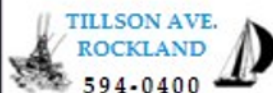
