### Annual Ash Wednesday Collection Benefits the Church in Central and Eastern Europe

Since the collapse of communism in the early 1990s, the countries in Central and Eastern Europe have been endeavored to rebuild, but the severe consequences of the oppressive Soviet rule continue to challenge all aspects of life in the region. Each year, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Collection for Central and Eastern Europe brings healing and opportunities for renewed life in Christ.

#### FAST & ABSTINENCE

- **Ash Wednesday & Good Friday** – Both Wednesday, February 22, 2023, and Friday, April 7, 2023, are days of fast and abstinence (from meat) in the universal Church.
- **Every Friday of Lent** – All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (from meat) in the Church in the United States.
- **The Law of Abstinence (from Meat)** – Binds Catholics aged 14 and older.
- **The Law of Fasting** – Binds Catholics aged 18 and over, until the beginning of their 60th year (through age 59).

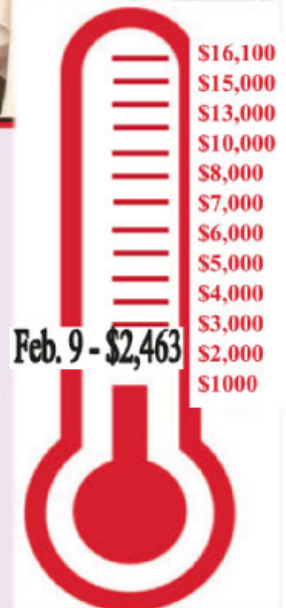
### CALLING ALL ST. BERNARD PARISHIONERS!

After much research, the St. Bernard Pastoral Team, along with input from the Knights and Daughters, has chosen a 5-foot statue (pictured right) from Abbott Church Goods. The statue is hand-carved and hand-painted from Lindenwood, and the estimated cost is \$16,100.

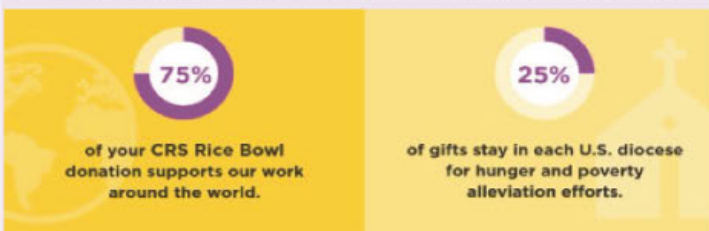

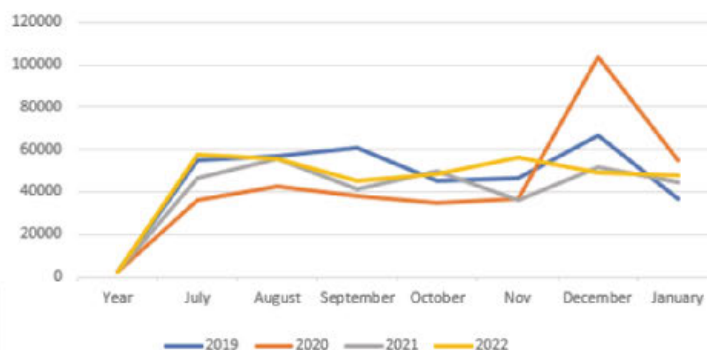
