
St. Katherine Drexel was born in Philadelphia in 1858. She took an avid interest in the well being of black and native Americans. She began by donating money but soon realized more was necessary.

She founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Black and Native American

peoples, dedicating her life and fortune of \$20 million to this work.

She opened the first mission school for Indians and many others for blacks in the south. She founded Xavier Univ sity in New Orleans.


Parishioners who receive Flocknote email will be notified by email.

And as always, we want you to be safe, please remain home if there is any question of travel. God understands!


