





In Laudato Si we are challenged to understand ecology as our relationship with God, oneself, other people and all of God's creation. Pope Francis calls it integral ecology, Pope John Paul II, ecological conversion. Both require transformation of mind and heart.



In our daily lives we must walk through the mysteries of transformation: tragedy, hurt, confusion, misunderstanding, injustice, pain, all felt not only personally but also what is seen in our chaotic world. We die a thousand little deaths in a lifetime but all the while God is with us. If we, like Jesus, can say "Father, into your hands I commend my Spirit", Luke 23;46, God can use these moments to transform us. This grace, the ability to forgive and show mercy requires only that we desire the closeness of God and dare to trust. With open hearts we enable someone or something to build the bridge we need to walk through each darkness to new life.
