



#### The Thing About Dominion

In Genesis 1, God created man and woman in his image and then ... (28) God blessed them saying: "Be fertile and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it. Have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, all the living things that move on the earth."

With a quick check of the dictionary, there a few words here that give one pause:

- Subdue= overcome, quieten, or bring under control
- Dominion= sovereignty (supreme power or authority) or control

Hasn't mankind's tendency to interact with nature in this very way led us to the predicament that we are currently in? Hasn't our tendency to take, take, take from nature and consume for our own advantage, without limitations, gotten us into trouble? So what's the deal here?

In Laudato Si (pp. 49-51), Pope Francis unpacks where humanity has gone astray and, not surprisingly, it is when things get taken out of context and attention not paid to the fullness of the gospel of creation. He tells us that the creation accounts in the book of Genesis contain profound teachings and, when taken as a whole, "suggest three fundamental and closely intertwined relationships:

· with God · with our neighbor · and with the earth itself'

When the harmony between these three is broken, the resulting rupture is sin. The harmony is broken when man presumes to take the place of God (seeks to be as wise as him) and refuses to acknowledge our creaturely limitations. The mandate to "have dominion" over the earth becomes distorted and the original harmonious relationship between human being and nature becomes conflictual. Saint Francis of Assisi experienced this rupture and tried to heal it in his calling for harmony with all creatures.

"We are not God. The earth is here before us and has been given to us" . . . . not for absolute dominion but rather "to till and keep" the garden of the world (cf Gen 2:15). "Tilling" refers to cultivating, ploughing or working, while "keeping" means caring, protecting, overseeing and preserving. This implies a relationship of mutual responsibility between human beings and nature. Each community can take from the bounty of the earth whatever its need for subsistence, but it also has the duty to protect the earth and ensure its fruitfulness for coming generations.

"The earth is the Lord's" (Ps21:1) ... He created it, it belongs to him ... thus God rejects every claim to absolute ownership. Misinterpretation of man's "dominion" over the earth has encouraged the unbridled exploitation of nature and other creatures. Our "ownership" of the land is really our wise stewardship of it for the time it is entrusted to us. We are mere "sojourners" (Lev 25:23), a person who resides in a place that is not primarily their own and who is dependent on the "good-will" of the community for their continued existence.

May we reflect on this enlightened view of dominion and ask God to help us be better sojourners and stewards of what he has entrusted to us during our time on earth.






