

A CALL FOR ECOLOGICAL SPIRITUALITY

In *Laudato Si*, Pope Francis elevates the concept of "ecological spirituality" that is grounded in the convictions of our faith. (LS 216) How is the interconnectedness of God, creation, and love for each other manifested around us, each and every day? And "how can such a spirituality motivate us to a more passionate concern for the protection of our world?"

What better time than during the season of Lent to consider our stewardship of God's creation in our reflection and prayer, in our fasting, and in our almsgiving. What better time to intentionally add this dimension to our personal faith?

A first step is keeping our eyes and ears open to this call in our scriptural readings, hymns, and prayers and then pausing to reflect on it more deeply. This first Sunday of Lent in the book of Genesis (9:8-15), we hear: "I am now establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you and with every living creature that is with you: all the birds, the various tame and wild animals... that never again shall all bodily creatures be destroyed..." Reflection: How am I doing with this promise? Are my habits, beliefs, and expressions of concern consistent with this covenant? Am I holding up my part of the bargain?

"May we recognize that human life is incomprehensible and unsustainable without other creatures. (LD67) For" as part of the universe...all of us are linked by unseen bonds and together form a kind of universal family, a sublime communion which fills us with a sacred, affectionate, and humble respect" (LS 42).






