

### Updated Diocesan Norms for the Reception of Holy Communion

#### Ending the practice of presenting the pyx at the Communion Line:

Though it does not happen as often in our parish, it has been the practice for some to present a pyx in the Communion line in order to receive a host to bring to the homebound. No later than July 31, 2025, this will no longer be allowed. To arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to a loved one, please call the parish office or email penny.wolfe@portlanddiocese.org and we will arrange a way for your loved one to receive Communion from an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion to the homebound on Sundays.

#### Low-Gluten Hosts:

The parish will continue to provide low-gluten hosts as it is no longer necessary, nor will be accepted, for the faithful to bring their own low-gluten host. For those wishing to receive a lowaluten host, please see the Sacristan before Mass to arrange this.

#### Did you know? Part 8 - Popo Leo XIV on LIFE

- Villanova University, Pope Leo XIV's alma mater, boasts the oldest collegiate pro-life club in the U.S. It remains very active today. Villanovans for Life was started in 1974, and a young Robert Prevost was one of its founders.
- As Bishop of Chiclayo, Peru, Pope Leo was very much involved in Peru's annual March for Life, the premier pro-life event in Peru under the leadership of the former Cardinal-Archbishop of Lima, Juan Luis Cipriani.
- In a homily given in Chiclayo in 2019 as then Bishop Prevost, Pope Leo said this: We cannot build a just society if we discard the weakest—whether the child in the womb or the elderly in their frailty—for they are both gifts from God.
- In a homily given this year to the Suburbicarian Diocese of Albano, Pope Leo said this: God's mercy calls us to protect every life, especially those society overlooks—the child yet to be born and the elderly nearing their journey's end—because each bears Christ's face.
