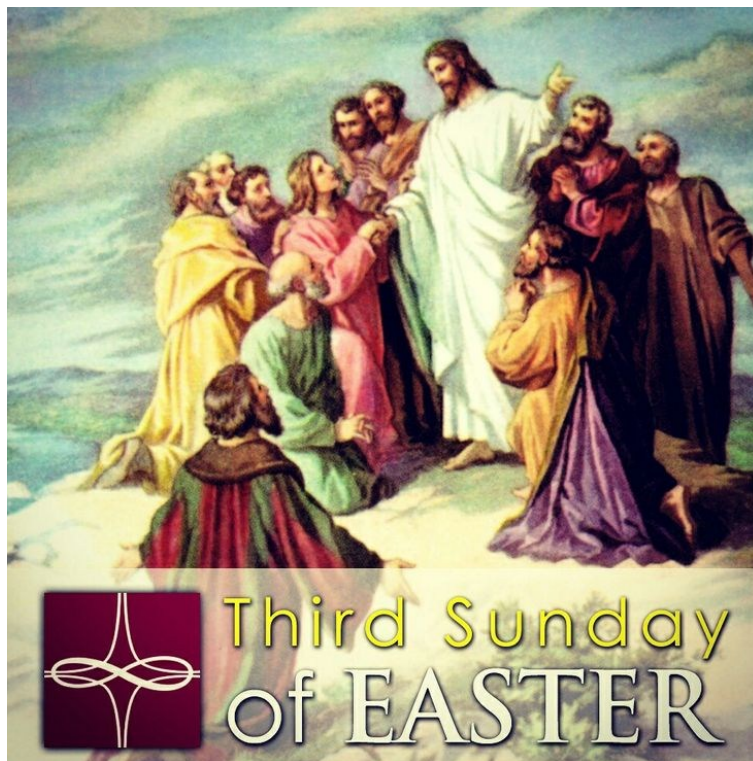

Mass of Thanksgiving for Canonization of Saint Carlo Acutis

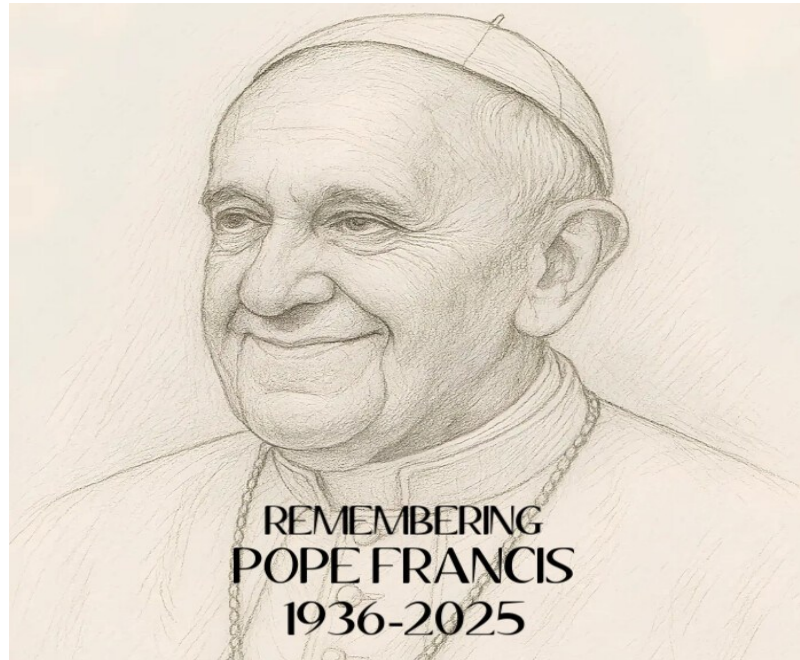
